The Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) is seeking an Intern for the Transportation Systems and Funding Department with planning and research work related to travel forecasting and transportation project development. Interns will gain knowledge in the data and techniques of travel forecasting and in the process to prepare transportation projects for construction.

Assignments may include specific activities or policy issues related to travel related data, travel demand modeling, traffic engineering, transportation project funding, or transportation project development. The ideal candidate should be able to conduct independent research, have solid experience in databases, math, and statistical analyses, and be able to gather, analyze, and summarize disparate data.

This position requires strong communication skills (both written and verbal) and organizational skills. Working knowledge of MS office databases, word-processing and spreadsheet software is essential. Good statistical analytical abilities are required, with familiarity with SPSS a plus. Experience with ArcGIS, SketchUp, and Access software is helpful. This is a team oriented position, although the applicant must possess the ability to work independently. A strong work ethic and excellent interpersonal skills are a must.

Applicant must be currently enrolled in a college or university. Fields related to Engineering, Transportation, City and Regional Planning, Urban Planning, Geography, or Economics are preferred.

Start date would be July 2017. Interns typically are employed up to 20 hours per week during semesters with classes and up to 40 hours during one semester per year with no or few classes.
