## MORPC Releases Top 40 High Crash Intersections

(Columbus –September 11, 2014) The Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) released its Top 40 Regional High-Crash Intersections list for the years 2011-2013. The top 40 intersections are ranked based on a formula that considers number of crashes, traffic volume and severity. The top ten intersections include:

1. Cleveland Avenue @ Morse Road
2. E Dublin Granville Road/SR 161 @ Maple Canyon Drive
3. E Broad Street/SR 16 @ James Road
4. W Broad Street/US 40 @ N Wilson Road
5. Cleveland Avenue @ Dublin Granville Road/SR 161
6. W Broad Street/US 40 @ Georgesville Road
7. S Hamilton Road/SR 317@ E Livingston Avenue
8. Cleveland Avenue @ Oakland Park
9. Cleveland Avenue @ Weber Road
10. E 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue @ Cleveland Avenue/SR 3
