I. INTRODUCTION

Public participation in the CapitalWays Transportation Plan has been early and continuous throughout the planning process. Participation included the cooperation and collaboration of local governments and resource agencies both on a project level and through comprehensive sub-plans, identification of needs from the general public through letters, emails and discussion, and involvement through internal structured committees.

Topics presented to the CAC, TAC and Policy committees, workshops, in press releases, legal notices and newsletters include projects, plans, studies and other issues that are discussed in the CapitalWays Transportation Plan. The following process demonstrates MORPC's commitment to involving the public in the transportation planning process and issues.

The MORPC Transportation Public Participation Process (PPP) is designed to provide the public an opportunity to participate in, to review, and to comment upon the formulation and recommendation of transportation plans, policies, and projects. This process provides a set of procedures to be consistently applied to incorporate public participation in the transportation planning process.

The PPP provides an opportunity for citizens to participate in transportation planning efforts including the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), the Transportation Plan (T-Plan), special transportation projects and other transportation issues. The Public Participation Process outlined in the following sections describes the opportunity for public input, and satisfies federal requirements for public involvement.

MORPC uses a variety of techniques to ensure public participation in the development of transportation plans, policies and projects. These methods include a structured internal committee process, a project-specific committee process, and a public outreach/information dissemination effort that is tailored to meet specific needs.

II. MORPC'S INTERNAL COMMITTEE STRUCTURE

MORPC's existing public participation structure incorporates the activities of two transportation committees, the Transportation Advisory Committee and the Policy Committee, as outlined below.

A. The Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC)

TAC is comprised of representatives from state, local and federal transportation agencies, the state Environmental Protection Agency, public utilities, counties, taxicab industry, railroads, trucks and charter bus/van operators. The Transportation Advisory Committee provides technical assistance and recommendations to the Transportation Policy Committee. TAC reviews the outline of procedures for the various phases of the study, methodology, projections, assumptions and recommended plans and programs before submission to the Policy Committee. TAC also advises the staff in the conduct of technical activity.

B. The Transportation Policy Committee (Policy Committee)

MORPC's Policy Committee consists of the Commission within the transportation planning area, plus representatives of ODOT, COTA, Franklin County, Delaware County, Pataskala, Etna Township in Licking County, Bloom and Violet Townships in Fairfield County, and the Ohio EPA. This committee, upon recommendations from TAC, makes final decisions on transportation plans, policies and projects.

In order to expand the opportunity for direct public input, MORPC hosts a Citizen Advisory Committee. The characteristics of this committee are summarized below.

C. The Citizen Advisory Committee (CAC)

The CAC provides broad representation from the community including, but not limited to, low-income and minority households, and those traditionally underserved by transportation including people with disabilities and seniors.

The CAC provides opportunities for citizens and special interest groups to participate in current transportation planning efforts such as the Transportation Plan, the Transportation Improvement Program, and transportation/air quality planning efforts and other appropriate projects and issues. The CAC provides recommendations to the Transportation Policy Committee. The CAC also advises staff on various phases of the study, methodology, projections, and assumptions and recommends plans and programs before submission to the Policy Committee.

III. PROJECT SPECIFIC PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT

Participation of the general public, special interest groups, state, local communities and technicians also occur through the formation of committees for specific studies. Each committee is reviewed to assure that the appropriate segments of the population are included; citizens from the study area, employers and affected local communities are duly represented. Both the transportation and the citizen advisory committees review the material and provide input into the study. The committee members assist with addressing study issues by answering questions at public meetings, open houses, project meetings and by providing information to local constituents.

A. Local Planning

Current community plans are reviewed to identify deficiencies and areas needing improvement. Each community was visited to ascertain the most recent planning documents or draft of a work-in-progress. The local communities are very helpful in coordinating and responding to this effort.

B. Agency Coordination

MORPC participates in the public meetings and open houses of COTA, ODOT, LCATS and local agencies. Information concerning the transportation project, the latest transportation plan, transportation improvement program, and recent studies are made available for review. Relevant drafts, maps, materials and contact information are provided to the public.

IV. PUBLIC OUTREACH/INFORMATION DISSEMINATION

Currently, MORPC involves the public in the transportation planning process through a variety of techniques. Public meetings, public hearings, open houses, task force meetings, ad hoc meetings, public forums, written comments, one-on-one contacts, community and group presentations, presentations to civic and business groups, and various committees are mechanisms used to seek participation into the planning process.

Outreach is also provided through a variety of techniques - MORPC's quarterly newsletter, *Transportation Connections*, MORPC's web page, www.morpc.org, and *Regional eSource*.

A. Public Outreach

MORPC currently has a strong public outreach program which includes the following:

Public notices are placed in the largest circulating daily local newspapers for each county prior to all public review periods and public hearings. Press releases are emailed to appropriate media announcing public review periods, hearings, open house meetings and other transportation planning efforts.

Information pertaining to various transportation activities can be found on MORPC's web site, www.morpc.org. Depending upon available resources and public interest, outreach efforts may use one or a combination of print media, electronic media, speakers' bureau and open houses to reach the protected segments of the population.

Direct mail notices provide information on the start of a project, the availability of the draft and final reports, comment periods, public meetings, how to provide comments and where additional information can be found. Direct mail notices are distributed to over 1200 residents, employers, resource agencies, social agencies, civic and neighborhood associations, area commissions, minority churches, townships, local jurisdictions, and the media.

B. Newsletter

MORPC produces and distributes a quarterly newsletter, *Transportation Connections*, which features articles on the various components of the transportation planning process. *Transportation Connections* is distributed to over 8500 by mail and another 400 to public libraries located in the planning area. *Transportation Connections* is also available on MORPC's web site.

C. Open House

An open house on the CapitalWays Transportation Plan was held on Thursday, April 3, 2008 from 4:00 to 7:00 p.m. Exhibits on the various elements of the transportation planning process were displayed. Staff was available to answer questions. A presentation on CapitalWays was provided and the audience given an opportunity to ask questions and provide comments.

D. Information Dissemination

MORPC currently advertises, through the media, the availability of draft and final transportation plans. Upon request, copies of transportation plans are mailed directly to individuals. MORPC's PPP expands this process to provide reasonable public access to technical and policy information used in the development of draft and final transportation plans. Appropriate transportation planning documents are made available at central public libraries, county departments of planning and/or departments of transportation, and MORPC.

Information is made available to the public upon reasonable request or by appointment. MORPC reserves the right to impose a reasonable fee to cover the costs and expenses of providing such information. MORPC publishes and distributes relevant information about the planning process and key decisions related to plans, policies, and projects on a regular basis. Additional information is made available at designated locations. Over 200 flyers announcing the CapitalWays Open House were distributed in press packets and sponsor bags for the Ohio Transportation Leadership Forum held March 19, 2008. Additional flyers were distributed at presentations and provided to groups with List Serves.

Information on comment periods, the availability of draft reports and public meetings are placed on staff's email signatures. This allows for an extended reach to all who communicate to MORPC staff through emails.

E. Speakers Bureau

In an effort to reach and involve the protected populations, MORPC presented general transportation planning and/or specific studies to neighborhood and civic associations, special interest groups and businesses. All public notifications announcing the availability of draft reports include language stating MORPC will present the draft study or report to their group.

With a consistent message and power point show, presentations on the draft CapitalWays Transportation Plan were scheduled with the following:

V. SUMMARY OF COMMENTS

Over 33 comments were received during the public comment period from March 3 thru April 11, 2008. Many comments covered more than one component of the CapitalWays Transportation Plan. However, the two components discussed most often were transit and highways. Much of the discussion on transit depicted confusion between the City of Columbus Streetcar project and COTA's light rail project. Questions asked after presentations clarified the status of the light rail project and its relationship to the streetcar. COTA's light rail project was not included in CapitalWays, however, many comments stressed the need for light rail. The highway comments ranged from considering an outer outerbelt to more specifics such as logical termini of roadways. One comment felt that MORPC ignored their plans and needs as their projects were not included in CapitalWays. Other comments discussed safety, Ridesolutions, livability, pedestrians, freight and bikeways.

As a result of the public comments made directly to MORPC during public presentations or sent through email, some changes were made to CapitalWays:

“I noted that Pickerington Rd/US 33 interchange was shown as “included project” and Winchester Rd/US 33 was shown as “not included project”. It is my understanding that ODOT has the Winchester Rd/US 33 interchange project as next in priority ahead of Pickerington Rd.” As a result of this comment, these two projects were switched.

“Grove City has grown substantially eastward. Obviously, the Stringtown Road access to and from the freeway system is essential, especially given the regional nature of the new commercial center...” Stringtown Road was added as a project as a result of this comment.

“Since the JRS roadway will be a controlled access roadway with properly spaced intersections and access points, it provides a better terminus for the widening of Broad Street from Taylor Road. The widening is currently shown to end at Mink Road.” As a result of this comment, the terminus was adjusted.

“The project list indicates SR 310 being widened to 4-lanes from US 40 to Mill Street. While this is needed, it will terminate at a historic 2-lane intersection in “Old Pataskala” and not provide 4-lane access to I-70. Widening should be considered between I-70 and US 40 on SR 310.” As a result of this comment, new interchanges were added along with a minor widening of SR 310.

Additional projects were added to Delaware City as a result of a CapitalWays presentation to Delaware City Council.

Additional intersection projects were added as a result of high crash locations identified in the Safety Plan.
