RESIDENTIAL ENERGY CONSERVATION CASE MANAGER/QUALITY ASSURANCE INSPECTOR (2 Positions)

The Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) is seeking two reliable, hardworking individuals to fill two positions of residential energy conservation case manager/quality assurance inspector. These are technical positions which require inspections of combustion appliances, building shell analyses, and electrical baseload. These positions are also responsible for monitoring subcontractor performance.

These positions will require the inspection of existing levels of insulation in attic, sidewalls, and possibly floor areas; perform blower door air infiltration test; determine cost effective replacements for electrical usage; perform Infrared Thermography scan of the building shell as well as other client related tasks.

This position requires the ability to follow verbal and written instructions as part of the team. Knowledge or ability to learn residential energy conservation theory and weatherization techniques as well as knowledge or ability to learn about gas-fired appliances, combustion theory, simple electricity and local codes are required. Formal training classes and certification is mandatory.

Individual must have a valid Ohio driver's license and a good driving record. A high school diploma or equivalent is required. Additional HVAC or weatherization training a plus.
