TRANSPORTATION ENGINEER/PLANNER/MODELER

The Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) is seeking a qualified entry to mid-level engineer/planner/modeler to perform a variety of traffic and other urban/rural transportation studies which may include: freeway and arterial analysis, development impact studies, travel demand forecasting, congestion management and multimodal incorporation. This position requires the completion of college training or professional transportation engineering/planning/modeling experience. MORPC is the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Columbus area.

The positions will work independently or as part of a team with moderate supervision to support transportation department initiatives including MPO planning studies, special projects and consultant activities. Experience with regional transportation demand modeling is required. Familiarity with Citilabs software is a plus. Knowledge of the principles of traffic engineering, HCM, travel demand forecasting, the underlying causes of travel, and programming is desired. Intermediate proficiency with spreadsheets, databases, and word processors and general use of Windows based computing is required. This position is also required to make effective communications via written reports and oral presentations to government officials, consultants, committees and other groups.

An advanced degree in Civil or Transportation Engineering is preferred, although other degrees such as City and Regional Planning, Transportation, Urban Planning, Geography or Economics with appropriate experience and coursework will be considered. A BS/BA in these fields, or similar related disciplines combined with a minimum of two years' appropriate experience is acceptable.
