Bikeways

General Comments

- Higher density/blend areas together
- Maintain the nature of the community
 - Keep the center of the community growing instead of expanding to the outside
 - Connect areas already existing should be the first step
- Agricultural Land
 - Protect Agriculture is in itself separate
 - Not a part of open space.
 - Needs to be differentiated on the map
 - Become more specific to the type of agriculture
 - Losing farm areas to subdivisions is a problem
- There is going to be a decrease in sprawl and therefore development outside of the central part of the community will decrease
- There will be more of a demand for active transportation
 - The demand for active transportation is not a trend
 - A greater need for different ways to get to place to place
- Be able to live and work in the same community
 - Tie the community together
- Trails need to be compatible with Agriculture
- Department of Agriculture would have to change their language....use for Agricultural uses only
 - Distinguish between different types of Agriculture using the same map
 - Put as an overlay
 - Need to be certain about agriculture because it limits where trails can be
