Metric: Bicycle and Pedestrian Crashes

The chart below shows the total number of crashes involving a vehicle and a bicyclist or pedestrian (including skaters and other non-motorized forms of transportation) in each county in central Ohio from 2003 to 2008. Once population is taken into account, the counties with the highest bicycle and pedestrian crash rates are Fayette, Franklin, and Marion. Morrow County has had very low numbers of bicycle and pedestrian crashes in the last 6 years.
