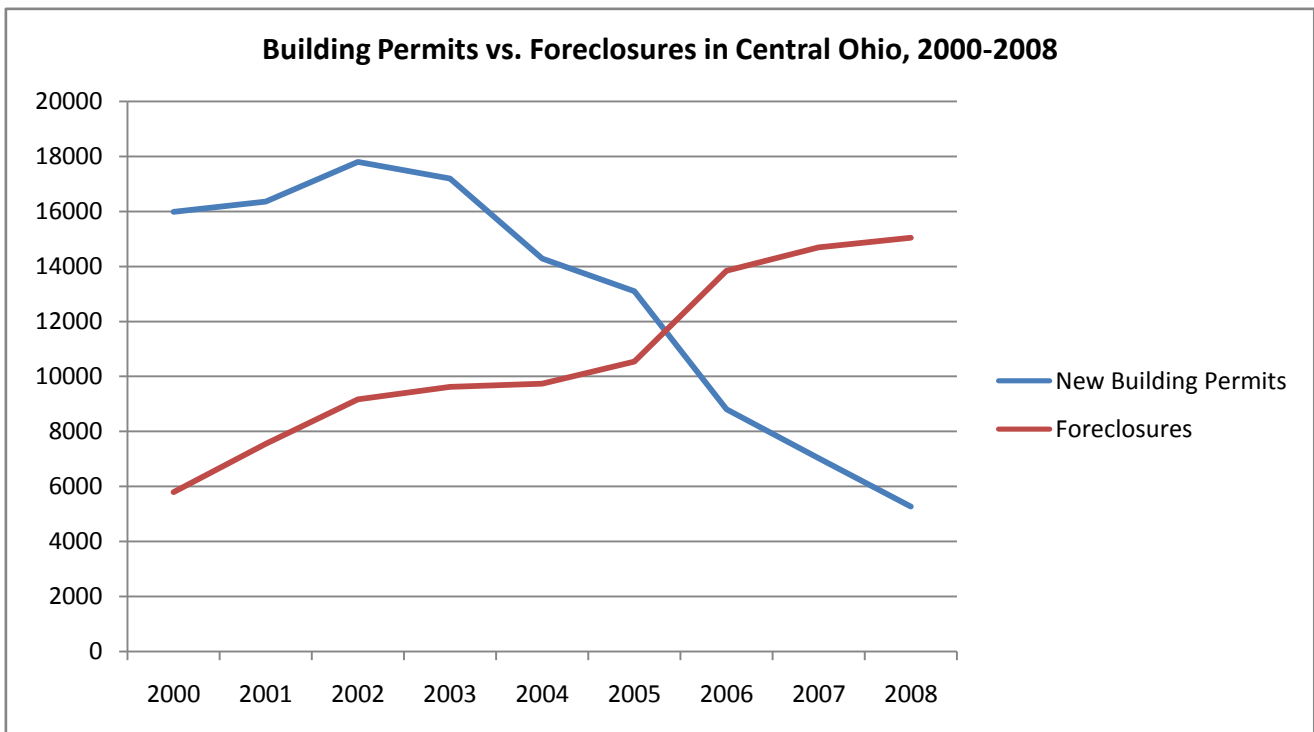
Issue: Prosperity
Metric: Foreclosures

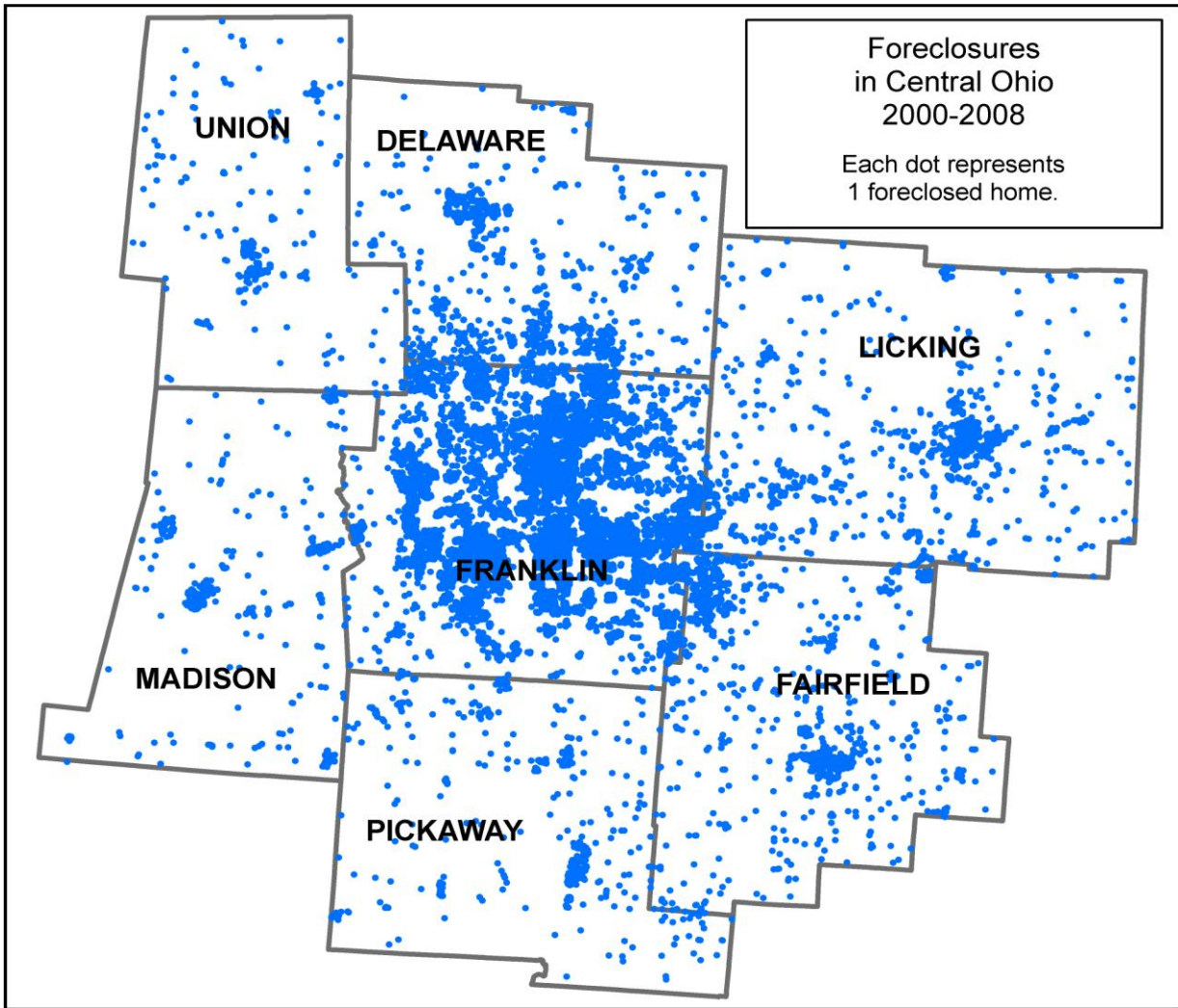
Residential foreclosures have been a growing crisis. Ohio has been one of the hardest hit states, and central Ohio has shared in the suffering. There were over 15,047 foreclosures in the region in 2008. Measured by number of households, Franklin and Marion Counties have been the most affected, with over 2% of households foreclosed upon in 2008.
