



TRANSPORTATION PLANNING INTERN

The Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) is seeking an Intern for the Transportation Department to use their college training which includes basic planning, research, statistical applications, and data analysis skills. This individual will mainly work on collecting, summarizing, and analyzing related data, including drawing inferences necessary for projects. This individual will be responsible to maintain spatial databases; perform statistical analysis of data; prepare interpretive maps for reports, presentations, and public meetings; and conduct field surveys.

This position requires strong communication skills (both written and verbal) and organizational skills. Experience with SPSS, GIS applications, and database management programs are preferred. Candidate must be familiar with hardware as well as software applications associated with map creation and production. The successful candidate should have experience and interest in the art of map making; statistical analysis; data management; and data collection procedures. Knowledge of basic math, algebra, statistics, and cartography required.

Applicant must be currently enrolled in a college or university. Fields related to City and Regional Planning, Transportation, Urban Planning, Geography, or Economics are preferred. An interest in pedestrian, bicycle, and safety planning is preferred.

Position may include 40 hours during the summer and during breaks and 20-25 hours during the school year.
