



## Annual Listing of Obligated Projects

State Fiscal Year 2008

September 30, 2008

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## Introduction and Background

In an effort to improve the transparency of the expenditure of Federal transportation funds, Congress requires transportation agencies to publish annually a listing of projects using these funds. 23 CFR 450.332 requires:

(a) In metropolitan planning areas, on an annual basis, no later than 90 calendar days following the end of the program year, the State, public transportation operator(s), and the MPO shall cooperatively develop a listing of projects (including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities) for which funds under 23 U.S.C. or 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53 were obligated in the preceding program year.

(b) The listing shall be prepared in accordance with §450.314(a) and shall include all federally funded projects authorized or revised to increase obligations in the preceding program year, and shall at a minimum include the TIP information under §450.324(e)(1) and (4) and identify, for each project, the amount of Federal funds requested in the TIP, the Federal funding that was obligated during the preceding year, and the Federal funding remaining and available for subsequent years.

(c) The listing shall be published or otherwise made available in accordance with the MPO's public participation criteria for the TIP.

MORPC is issuing this report to meet this requirement.

The State of Ohio, public transit operators, and MORPC coordinated their efforts to generate those data contained in this report. This report covers funding obligated during the period from July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008 being State Fiscal Year 2008. To be included in this listing, an obligated project must be either entirely or partially located within MORPC's transportation planning area. The obligated amounts shown in the report are attributable to entire projects, including those portions located outside of the planning area. The planning area is composed of Franklin and Delaware counties, the City of Pataskala and Etna Township in Licking County, and Violet and Bloom townships and the City of Pickerington in Fairfield County.

An obligation is the Federal government's legal commitment to pay the Federal share of a project's cost. An obligated project is one that the Federal agency has authorized and for which it has obligated funds. Projects obligated in a certain fiscal year are not necessarily initiated or completed in that fiscal year, and the amount of the obligation will not necessarily equal the total cost of the project. For Federal Transit Administration (FTA) projects, an obligation occurs when the FTA awards a grant. For Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) projects, an obligation occurs when a project agreement is executed and the State/grantee requests that the funds be obligated.

## Report Organization

This report is intended to provide technical information that transportation professionals use in a format understandable by anyone interested in surface transportation improvements in the MORPC study area.

The report includes three tables:

- Table 1 lists information for projects for which Federal funds were obligated in SFY 2008. The table includes a project description, sponsoring agency, types of bicycle and pedestrian facilities

included in the project (if any), project phase, Federal amount included in the TIP, the obligated amount, and the remaining amount. Projects are grouped by the primary type of work (Arterial Expansion, Bikeway, Bridge Repair & Replacement, etc.). Within these groupings, projects are ordered by County-Route-Section. (See Guide to 2008 Obligated Fund Listing below.)

- Table 2 is a listing of projects in Table 1 that include investments in bicycle transportation facilities in some phase of the project. It only highlights the projects in Table 1 that include these investments and does not contain any additional information.
- Similarly, Table 3 is a listing of projects in Table 1 that include investments in pedestrian walkways in some phase of the project. It only highlights the projects in Table 1 that include these investments and does not contain any additional information.

## Guide to 2008 Obligated Project Listing

Below is a guide to some of the headings and abbreviations used in the tables on the following pages.

**MORPC ID** – Identification number that MORPC has assigned to track the project.

**State ID** – The identification number assigned by the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT). (NA = None Assigned.)

**Agency** – The agency that is sponsoring the project.

- COTA = Central Ohio Transit Authority
- CRAA = Columbus Regional Airport Authority
- ODNR = Ohio Department of Natural Resources
- ODOT = Ohio Department of Transportation, with District number
- ORDC = Ohio Rail Development Commission

**County-Route-Section** - Identifies project by county, route and section mileage designations, where applicable. Project phase or segment identification may also be indicated.

The list for each group of projects is sorted in this order:

- 1st by County in alphabetical order
- 2nd by projects without route numbers in alphabetical order by Route
- 3rd by projects with route numbers in numerical order by Route
- 4th by Section in alpha-numerical order

**County** – County in which the project is located. (DEL = Delaware, FRA = Franklin, FAI = Fairfield, LIC = Licking).

**Route** – Route designation and number (IR = Interstate, US = United States, SR = State, CR = County, TR = Township) or municipal street name.

**Section** – Distance in miles from start of the route in the county to the start of the project, based on ODOT's system mileage section as designated by ODOT.

**Bike Facility** – Type of bicycle facility that is included in the construction of the project.

- Not Applicable = The Bike Facility field does not apply for the project.
- None = No dedicated bike facility is planned for the project.
- Yes-TBD = A dedicated bike facility is planned, but the type of facility has yet To Be Determined.
- Class I = A facility separated from automobile traffic (e.g., bike path) is planned.
- Class II = A facility NOT separated from automobile traffic (e.g., bike lane) is planned.
- Other = Other type of bicycle facility, for example, a wide shoulder or bicycle racks.

**Ped Facility** – Type and location of pedestrian facilities, exclusive of bicycle/multi-use facilities, that are included in the construction of the project.

- Not Applicable = The Pedestrian Facility field does not apply for the project.
- New 1 Side = A new pedestrian facility is planned to be added on 1 side.
- New 2 Sides = A new pedestrian facility is planned to be added on 2 sides.
- Replace 1 to 1 = An existing pedestrian facility on 1 side is planned to be replaced.
- Replace 1 to 2 = An existing pedestrian facility on 1 side is planned to be replaced on 2 sides.
- Replace 2 to 2 = An existing pedestrian facility on 2 sides is planned to be replaced.
- Replace 2 to 1 = An existing pedestrian facility on 2 sides is planned to be replaced on 1 side.
- Other = Other type of pedestrian facility, for example, a wide shoulder or transit shelter.

**Phase** – Describes the project development activity for which funds were obligated (Right-of-Way, Construction, etc.).

**TIP Amount** – The amount of Federal funds requested in MORPC's Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), as amended, for SFYs 2008-2011.

**Obligated Amount** – The amount of Federal funding obligated during State Fiscal Year 2008.

**Remaining Amount** – The amount of Federal funding remaining and available for subsequent years. An asterisk (\*) indicates that no Federal funds remain for the project phase for subsequent years.

Other transportation-specific acronyms used in the listing:

- **ITS** – Intelligent Transportation Systems
- **TDM** – Transportation Demand Management
