## Open House Scheduled for SR 310 Corridor Study

**(COLUMBUS, November 2006)** - Representatives from the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) will host a public open house this week for the SR 310 Corridor Study. The SR 310 Study is a joint effort of MORPC, Etna Township, Licking County, the City of Pataskala, Fairfield County and ODOT. The open house is scheduled for Wednesday, November 29, in the Council Chambers of the Pataskala City Hall from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. The address of the Pataskala City Hall is 621 West Broad Street, Pataskala, Ohio, 43062.

The SR 310 Corridor Study Team will present the purpose, scope and goals of the study as well as the study process. The public is encouraged to attend and offer comments on the information presented.

Designated as central Ohio's metropolitan planning agency, MORPC is a voluntary association of 42 local governments. MORPC serves as a community resource in the region by providing comprehensive planning, programming and brokerage services in the areas of transportation, land use, energy conservation, environment, housing, air quality and public policy.

MORPC coordinates regional transportation planning in Franklin and parts of Delaware, Fairfield and Licking counties. It is a voluntary association of 42 local governments in central Ohio serving the region through planning, direct service, public policy information and innovative programming and services in transportation, land use, energy conservation, the environment and housing.
