Mayor Coleman's Five Principles for Joint Long Range Growth Planning

1. Provide public facilities, infrastructure and services to the area and cover their costs.
2. Engage the private sector so that those who benefit help pay for necessary services.
3. Create job and housing opportunities for citizens in the northwest and balance jobs with residential growth.
4. Grow the regional economy with new jobs and don't take jobs from other communities.
5. Allocate revenue generated in the northwest region to service businesses and residents in the region.
