



Annual Listing of Obligated Projects

State Fiscal Year 2010

September 30, 2010

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Introduction and Background

In an effort to improve the transparency of the expenditure of Federal transportation funds, Congress requires transportation agencies to publish annually a listing of projects using these funds. 23 CFR 450.332 requires:

(a) In metropolitan planning areas, on an annual basis, no later than 90 calendar days following the end of the program year, the State, public transportation operator(s), and the MPO shall cooperatively develop a listing of projects (including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities) for which funds under 23 U.S.C. or 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53 were obligated in the preceding program year.

(b) The listing shall be prepared in accordance with §450.314(a) and shall include all federally funded projects authorized or revised to increase obligations in the preceding program year, and shall at a minimum include the [Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)] information under §450.324(e)(1) and (4) and identify, for each project, the amount of Federal funds requested in the TIP, the Federal funding that was obligated during the preceding year, and the Federal funding remaining and available for subsequent years.

(c) The listing shall be published or otherwise made available in accordance with the MPO's public participation criteria for the TIP.

MORPC is issuing this report to meet this requirement.

This report covers funding obligated during the period from July 1, 2009, to June 30, 2010, being State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2010. To be included in this listing, an obligated project must be either entirely or partially located within MORPC's transportation planning area. The obligated amounts shown in the report are attributable to entire projects, including those portions located outside of the planning area. The planning area is composed of Franklin and Delaware counties, the City of Pataskala and Etna Township in Licking County, and the following jurisdictions in Fairfield County: the City of Pickerington, the Villages of Carroll (part) and Lithopolis, and Bloom and Violet Townships.

An obligation is the Federal government's legal commitment to pay the Federal share of a project's cost. An obligated project is one that the Federal agency has authorized and for which it has obligated funds. Projects obligated in a certain fiscal year are not necessarily initiated or completed in that fiscal year, and the amount of the obligation will not necessarily equal the total cost of the project. For Federal Transit Administration (FTA) projects, an obligation occurs when the FTA awards a grant. For Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) projects, an obligation occurs when a project agreement is executed and the State/grantee requests that the funds be obligated.

The Ohio Department of Transportation supplied the data for obligated projects and the obligated amounts. MORPC did not attempt to verify the data and does not guarantee their accuracy or completeness. MORPC matched the obligations in these data to the funding commitments in the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for SFYs 2008-2011 and subsequent amendments.

Report Organization

This report is intended to provide technical information that transportation professionals use in a format understandable by anyone interested in surface transportation improvements in the MORPC study area.

The report includes three tables:

- Table 1 lists information for projects for which Federal funds were obligated in SFY 2010. The table includes a project description, sponsoring agency, types of bicycle and pedestrian facilities included in the project (if any), project phase, Federal amount listed in the original SFY 2008-2011 TIP or subsequent TIP amendments, the obligated amount, and the remaining amount. Projects are grouped by the primary type of work (Arterial Expansion, Bikeway, Bridge Repair & Replacement, etc.). Within these groupings, projects are ordered by County-Route-Section. (See Guide to 2010 Obligated Fund Listing below.)
- Table 2 is a listing of projects in Table 1 that include investments in bicycle transportation facilities in some phase of the project. It only highlights the projects in Table 1 that include these investments and does not contain any additional information.
- Similarly, Table 3 is a listing of projects in Table 1 that include investments in pedestrian walkways in some phase of the project. It only highlights the projects in Table 1 that include these investments and does not contain any additional information.

Guide to 2010 Obligated Project Listing

Below is a guide to some of the headings and abbreviations used in the tables on the following pages.

MORPC ID – Identification number that MORPC has assigned to track the project.

ODOT PID – The identification number assigned by the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT).

Agency – The agency that is sponsoring the project.

- COTA = Central Ohio Transit Authority
- CRAA = Columbus Regional Airport Authority
- DATA = Delaware Area Transit Agency
- ODOT = Ohio Department of Transportation, with District number
- ORDC = Ohio Rail Development Commission

County-Route-Section - Identifies project by county, route and section mileage designations, where applicable. Project phase or segment identification may also be indicated.

The list for each group of projects is sorted in this order:

- 1st by County in alphabetical order
- 2nd by projects without route numbers in alphabetical order by Route
- 3rd by projects with route numbers in numerical order by Route
- 4th by Section in alpha-numerical order

County – County in which the project is located. (DEL = Delaware, FRA = Franklin, FAI = Fairfield, LIC = Licking, MAD = Madison). Projects in multiple counties have the designation D05 or D06 (for ODOT District 5 or District 6) or STW (statewide).

Route – Route designation and number (IR = Interstate, US = United States, SR = State, CR = County, TR = Township) or municipal street name.

Section – Distance in miles from start of the route in the county to the start of the project, based on ODOT's system mileage section as designated by ODOT.

Bike Facility – Description of bicycle accommodations that are associated with the project.

Ped Facility – Description of pedestrian facilities or accommodations associated with the project.

Phase – Describes the project development activity for which funds were obligated (Right-of-Way, Construction, etc.).

TIP Amount – The amount of Federal funds listed in MORPC’s Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), as amended, for SFYs 2008-2011.

Obligated Amount – The amount of Federal funding obligated during State Fiscal Year 2010.

Remaining Amount – The amount of Federal funding remaining and available for subsequent years. An asterisk (*) indicates that no Federal funds remain for the project phase for subsequent years.
