Transportation Review Advisory Council (TRAC)



- Commits ODOT funding for Major New Capacity Program projects
- Criteria for project eligibility:
 - Overall cost over \$12 million
 - Increase capacity and/or reduce congestion
 - Proves to support jobs and/or job creation
- MPOs provide ODOT a local project prioritization recommendation


2020 Cycle suspended

Accelerated 2021 Cycle

- Option for 2020 TRAC applicants to leave applications as submitted
- Jim Gates (TRAC Manager) had to be notified of 2020 application revisions by March 1
- New applications were accepted within application period

Metropolitan Transportation Plan – Adopted May 2020






\$30 Billion

- \$3.4B Freeway-Related


Implemented by state and local governments through a variety of federal, state and local funding programs and sources



Freeways

- Specific projects in the MTP
 - -88 new lane miles
 - -25 interchange modifications
 - —6 new interchanges
 - —4 corridors for managed lanes
 - -Other


Funded primarily through ODOT programs (like TRAC), with mostly federal funding and some state and local dollars

No Significant Action


