





TRAIL PRIORITIZATION

IMPACTS OF TRAILS



North Carolina

A 2018 study found that \$1 invested in one-time trail construction generates \$1.72 of economic return.

Maine

Since 1991, Main generated \$66 million a year in bicycle tourism as of 2001 based on their concerted efforts to create more bicycle / trail infrastructure.

Delaware River Watershed

Study concluded that ROI on their trail network could be 10-fold, generating \$3 billion in benefits.
