## Central Ohio

Air quality conditions in Columbus for April 2020 are better than those during the same period in 2018 and 2019. In April 2020, conditions were in the Good AQI category on 93% of days.

Ozone levels in Columbus typically begin to ramp up in April as temperatures warm and daylight hours increase. However, in April 2020, below-average temperatures limited ozone production in Columbus. Furthermore, the majority of the days with temperatures at or above 70°F had measurable precipitation and cloud cover, which inhibited ozone formation. The lone exception was April 4, which had sunny and calm conditions; this was the only Moderate ozone AQI day in April 2020. Frequent frontal passages and windy conditions helped to keep PM<sub>2.5</sub> levels in the Good AQI category on most days.
