Project Benefits

- Maintains competitive infrastructure by replacing a bridge with inadequate width, ensuring that trucks and farm vehicles can safely cross
- Adds value to the transportation system by allowing load restrictions to be removed from the road corridor
- Maximizes existing infrastructure by utilizing existing roads in already-developed corridors
- Maintains important regional connections between the US 23 corridor, Eastern Ross County, and Tar Hollow State Park
