Title VI of the U.S. Civil Rights Act of 1964

In operating a federally-assisted program, a recipient cannot, on the basis of **race**, **color**, or **national origin**, either directly or through contractual means:

- Deny program services, aids, or benefits;
- Provide a different service, aid, or benefit, or provide them in a manner different than they are provided to others; or
- Segregate or separately treat individuals in any matter related to the receipt of any service, aid, or benefit.

Ongoing Title VI Activities

- Title VI Assurances by resolution each year
- Data Collection (and Planning) monitor Title VI protected areas
- Public Involvement Plan assist in planning and decision making
- External Complaint Process maintain in accessible locations
- Limited English Proficiency Plan serve non English speaking populations
- Diversity and Inclusion Work Plan support, encourage, and promote MORPC work with diverse populations
- Contract Procedures specific Title VI text and processing requirements
