

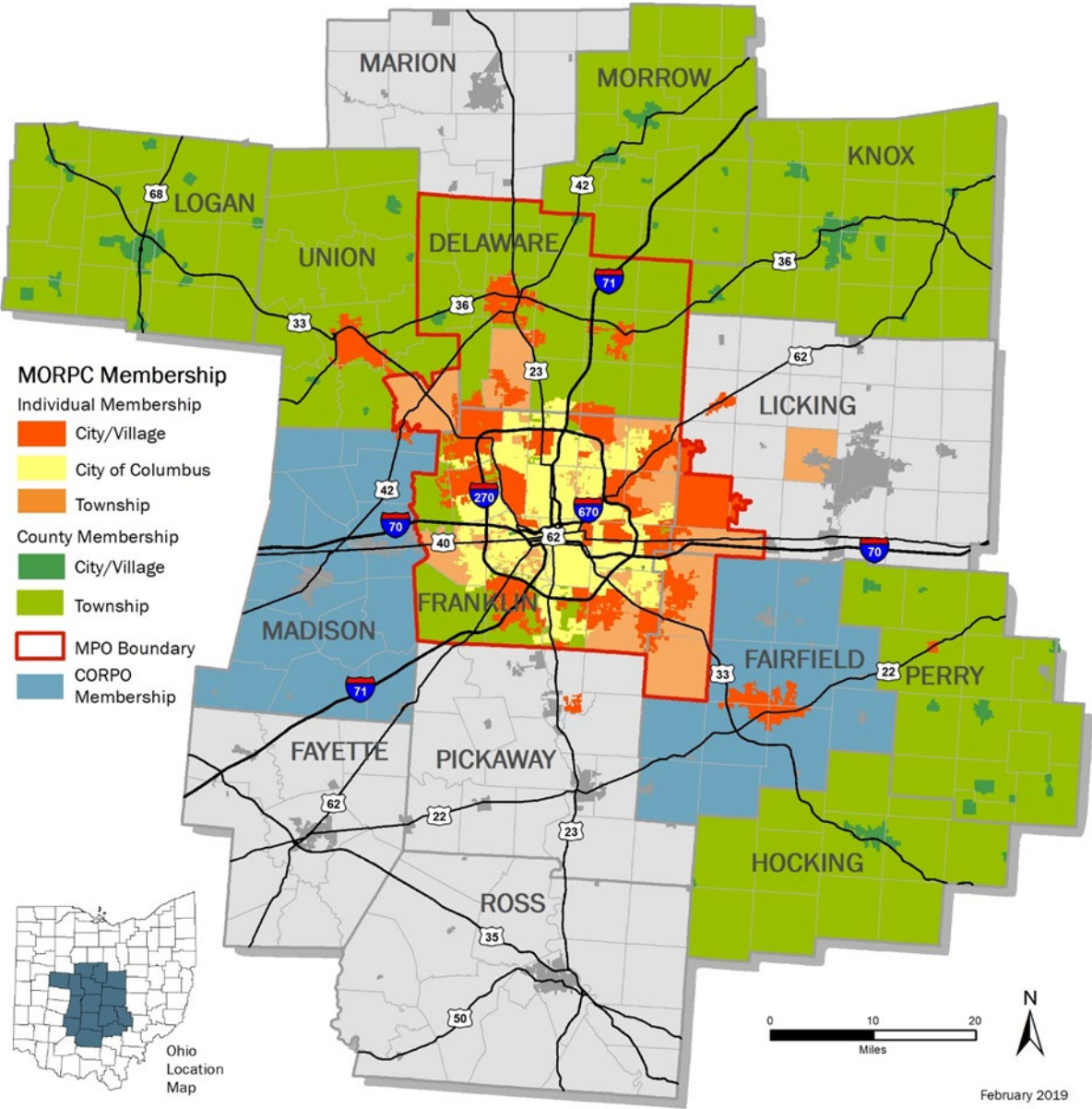

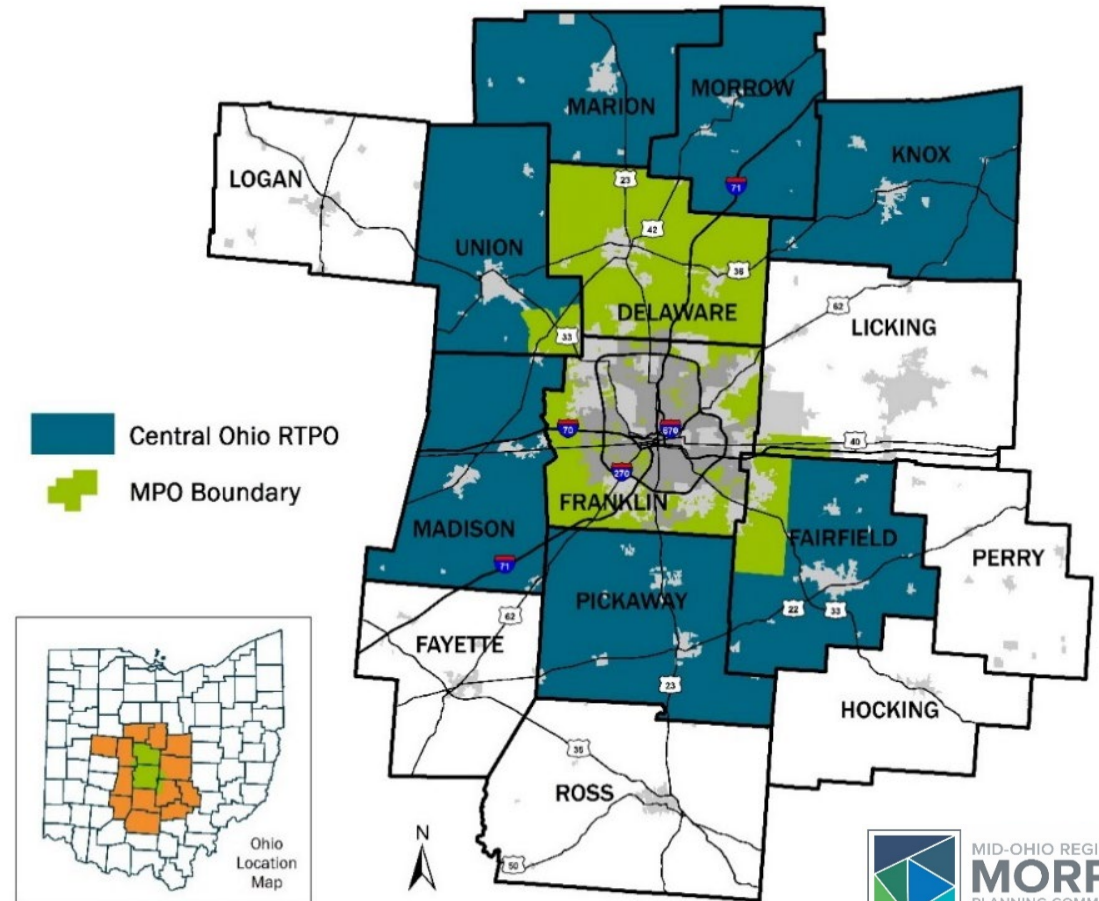

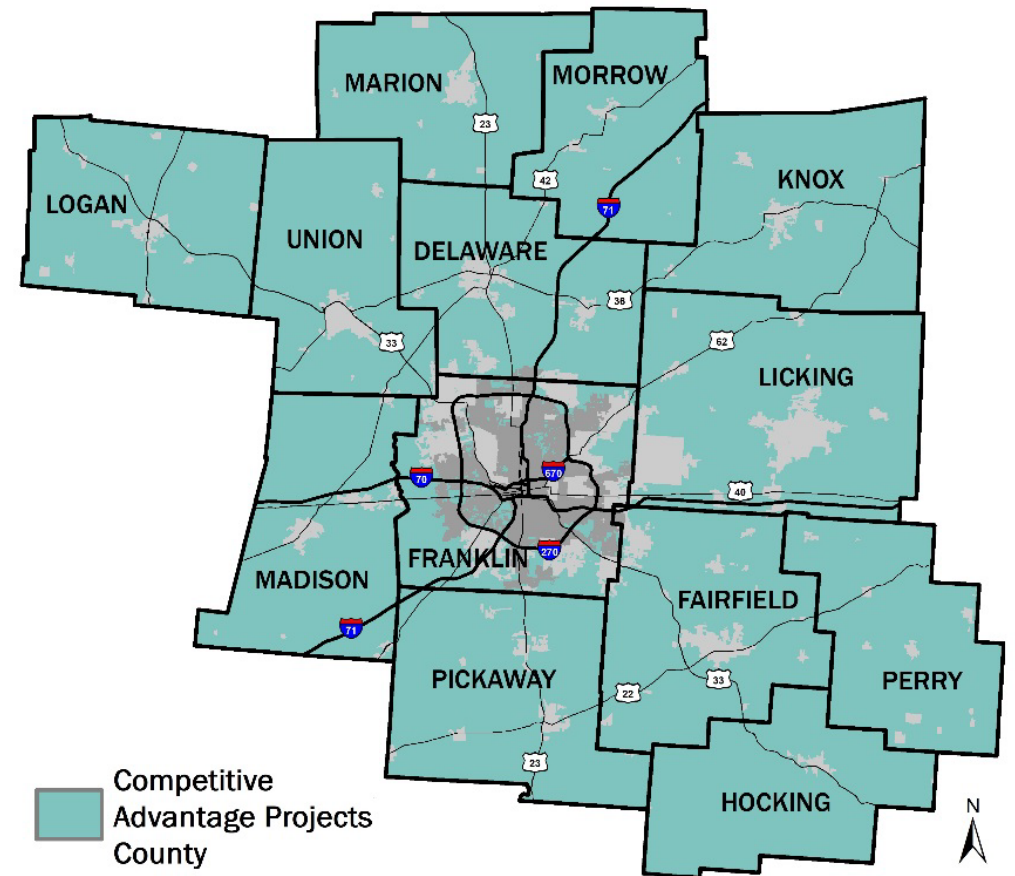
CENTRAL OHIO RURAL PLANNING ORGANIZATION (RTPO)

- Federal and state recognized – voluntary membership of seven counties outside MORPC & LCATS MPOs
- Coordinated transportation planning between rural stakeholders and ODOT
- Produce long-range transportation plan



COMPETITIVE ADVANTAGE

- Initiative to develop and maintain a list of vetted infrastructure projects
- Each county was asked to identify their top infrastructure priorities
- Projects advanced through advocacy and technical assistance
- List updated for 2019-2020 legislative sessions

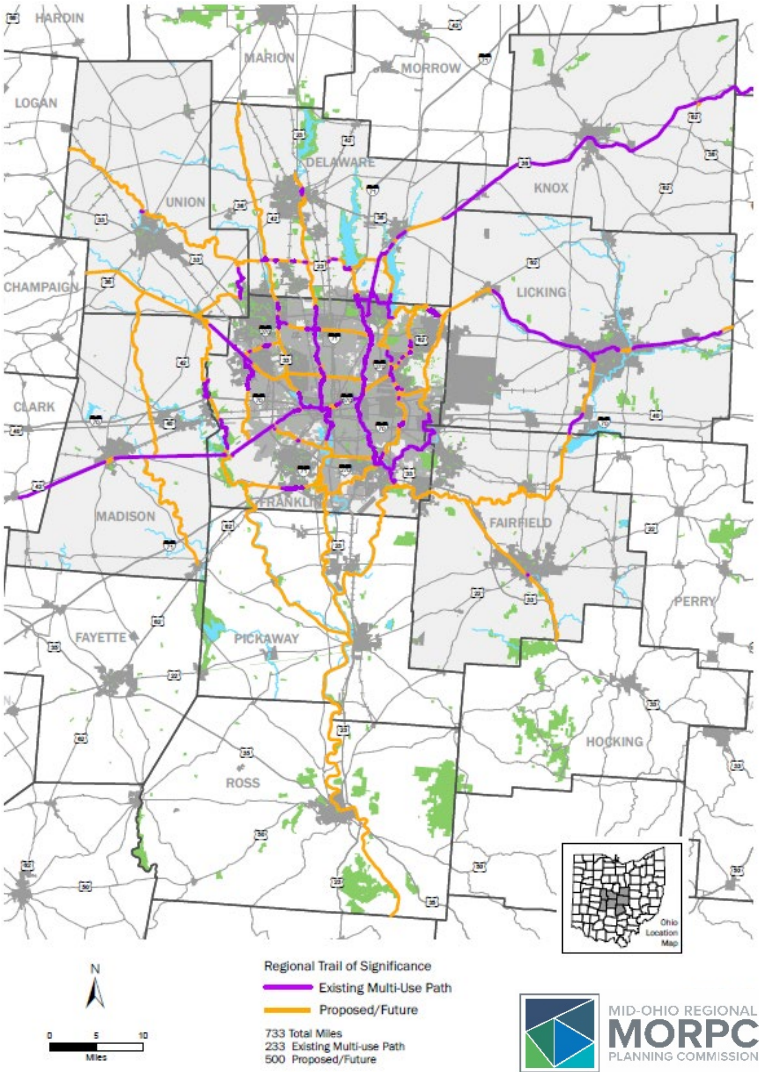
