Re: Support for the Columbus Crossroads INFRA Application

Dear Secretary Chao:

I am writing to you today to express my support for the Infrastructure for Rebuilding America (INFRA) grant for Phase 4 of the Columbus Crossroads project, which would change the crossroads of Interstates 70 and 71 Downtown Columbus.

Replacing outdated highway infrastructure through the Columbus Crossroads project would both improve freight movement across Ohio, and revitalize Downtown Columbus and its surrounding neighborhoods. Phase 4 specifically focuses on the physical overlap between I-70 and I-71, which serves commuter traffic across Central Ohio and freight across the Midwest. This phase costs approximately \$265 million, and is essential for improving safety and reducing both commuter and pedestrian congestion.

The Columbus Crossroads project has been identified as a top priority across the City of Columbus, the Central Ohio region, and the State of Ohio. However, the project cannot be completed without additional funding from the INFRA grants.
