# A RESOLUTION BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE AMENDMENT TO AND MODIFCATION OF THE CALENDAR YEAR 2021 FUND BUDGETS AND RELATED ACTIONS

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Transportation Improvement District (FCTID), in accordance with applicable sections of the Ohio Revised Code and common budgetary best practices desires to adopt and to amended certain fund budgets for calendar year 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the FCTID's funds are utilized in a manner so as to properly account for revenues and expenditures of the FCTID and to comply with applicable budgetary requirements of the Ohio Revised Code: and

WHEREAS, furthermore, the FCTID in conjunction and cooperation with the Franklin County Engineer's Office ("FCEO"), is advancing the Toy Road/Saltzgaber Road/Swisher Road Improvement Project to construction, in accordance with the intergovernmental agreement with the County, dated November 26, 2019, as amended, and the FCEO is now prepared to advertise and bid for project construction services, with a portion of the project costs to be funded by current and pledged resources of the FCTID, including funds in the amount of \$847,795.00 currently on deposit with the FCTID and a credit of \$453,501.78 to the FCEO against the FCEO's 2021 pledged funding commitment to the FCTID in the original amount of \$500,000.00, thus reducing the FCEO's 2021 funding commitment to \$46,498.22 after such credit, and making the FCTID's gross contribution to the project in current resources, and waived pledged commitments, in the amount of \$1,301,296.78; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to adjust, amend and to adopt estimated resources and appropriations as set forth on the attached schedule, and to properly account for expenditures of the FCTID and to comply with budgetary requirements, in accordance with the schedule attached hereto and made part hereof; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the FCTID Board of Trustees (the "Board") hereby approves, authorizes and directs its Secretary-Treasurer to amend and adopt the calendar year 2021 fund budgets, in accordance with the schedule attached hereto and made part hereof.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board hereby authorizes and directs the FCTID Secretary-Treasurer to disburse funds in the amount of \$847,795.00 to the FCEO and to credit funding to the FCEO in the amount of \$453,501.78 against the FCEO's 2021 original pledged funding commitment amount of \$500,000.00, for the partial funding of construction costs for the Toy Road/Saltzgaber Road/Swisher Road Improvement.

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law, including § 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and House Bill 404 provisions.
