# IIJA AND BIL OVERVIEW

- IIJA / BIL holds the same
  - Funding
  - Programs
  - Priorities
- Signed by President Biden
  - November 15, 2021
- Authorizes
  - \$1.2 trillion overall
  - \$550 billion for new programs
  - Funds over 350 programs
- Resources
  - Government Finance Officers Association
  - BIL Launchpad
  - The White House
  - Federal Agencies

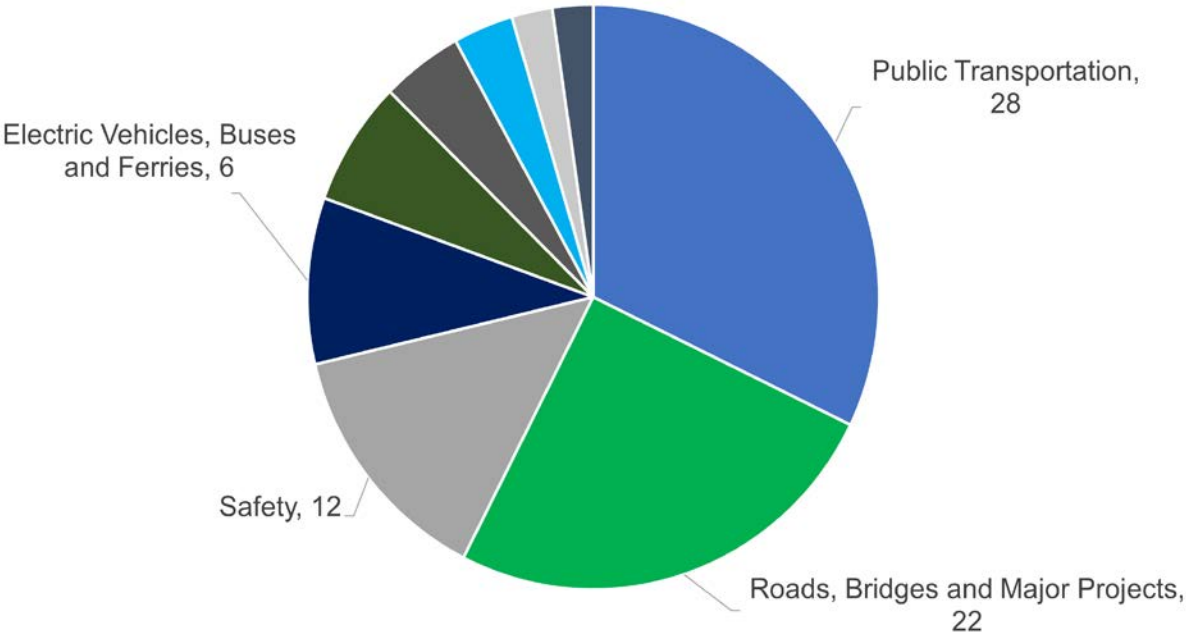

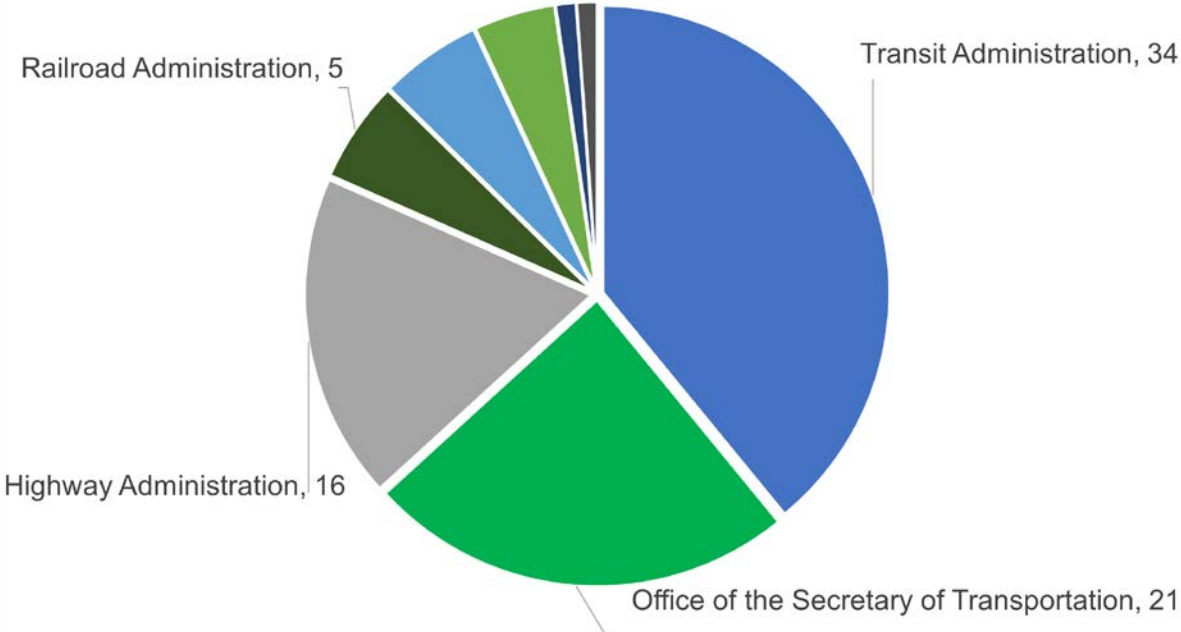

# MORPC APPROACH

- Formula Funds
  - MORPC receives multiple formulated funds from IIJA and BIL
    - Surface Transportation Block Grant
      - +12.7% from FAST Act
    - Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality
      - +25.6% from FAST Act
    - Transportation Alternatives Program
      - +33.8% from FAST Act
    - Carbon Reduction Program
      - New Program
  - These funds enable MORPC's Attributable Funding Program
- Preparing The Region
  - Application Assistance
  - Benefit-Cost Analysis
  - War Room
  - Safety Analysis
  - Safety Action Plans
  - MTP
