

WHYDO WE STOP AT THE ZIP CODE?

Data Limitations

 Most datasets don't reference a census tract, neighborhood, or other drilled down geographic area

Convenience

- Zip Code Tabulation Areas are industry standards for geographical analysis
- "Neighborhood" can mean different boundaries to different people.


Privacy Concerns

A person's address is protected information

WHY SHOULD WE GO BEYOND THE ZIP CODE?

OPPORTUNITY IN 43204

- One zip code contains a multitude of neighborhoods and communities.
- The composition of each has profound lasting impacts for the people who live there.
- Opportunity Index Kirwan Institute
- Opportunity is a set of conditions Health, Housing, Education, Employment, and Transportation.
- Opportunity Index Score: Westgate (83) and Central Hilltop (29)
- We miss the structural components and historical context of our neighborhoods if we don't look closer.



HOW DO WE GO BEYOND THE ZIP CODE?



Make Administrative Data Work for You

All you need are addresses to start analyzing beyond the zip code level.



Create Your Own Geolocator

The Franklin County Auditor's data can be extracted and used as a reference for creating your own Locator.



Aggregate the Data for Privacy

Once all your points are plotted, aggregate your data with clusters, bins, or density.

Many organizations have GIS data readily accessible for creating and bolstering any analysis.


Leverage Publicly Available Resources

Once your locator is built, you can geocode your address data without relying on a service or third party.





South of I-70, East of I-71




WHEN ADDRESS IS YOUR BEST IDENTIFIER

WHY?

- Administrative Data is prone to errors
 - > Transposed street numbers, missing unit numbers, incorrect street types
- Point-to-point spatial joins or relates require precision geocoding
- Using proximity largely resolves these and reduces the complexity of matching solely on string variables

HOW?


- 1. Geocode PRC Approvals and Evictions
- 2. Generate a Nearby Table of Evictions near PRC Recipients
 - Potential matches made for Evictions within 225' radius of each PRC Recipient
- 3. Merge your datasets and confirm matches with shared data elements
 - Crosschecked against names, Unit numbers, and timeframe of PRC Application and Filings





Average Time between Emergency
Housing Assistance Approval and
Subsequent Eviction Filing:

6 - 8 Months



Percent of Households Avoiding Subsequent Eviction Filings



The JCHS at Harvard found ERA is associated with substantial short-term benefits including:

- Lower likelihood of being behind on rent
- Reduced chance of having difficulty meeting expenses, using savings funds, or borrowing from friends/family
- Lower probability of food insecurity
- Lower rates of reported mental health concerns

SNAP AND FOOD DESERTS

Franklin County has nearly **70,000 families** on the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), formerly referred to as "food stamps". Families on SNAP can only use their EBT at approved vendors and have limitations on what can be purchased.

The USDA defines a Food Desert as:

- low-income (LI): poverty rate of 20% or greater, or median family income at or below 80% of the statewide or metropolitan area median family income; and
- low-access (LA): a low-income tract with at least 500 people or 33% of the tract's population <u>living more than 1 mile</u> (urban areas) or more than 10 miles (rural areas) from the <u>nearest supermarket or grocery store</u>.

HOW FOOD DESERTS HARM COMMUNITIES


- What's the harm in living more than 1 mile from a grocer or supermarket?
 - Convenience stores fill that void. Meat and produce options are usually nonexistent.
 - Lack of access to healthy food has long-lasting implications for families
- Food apartheid
 - "Healthy, fresh food is accessible in wealthy neighborhoods while unhealthy food abounds in poor neighborhoods." – Karen Washington, food justice advocate



A food benefits program approached the Commissioners on running a Pilot in Franklin County.

 An aspect of the program would allow SNAP households to order groceries to be delivered at no cost to them.

 If the pilot were greenlit, where should it be targeted?


