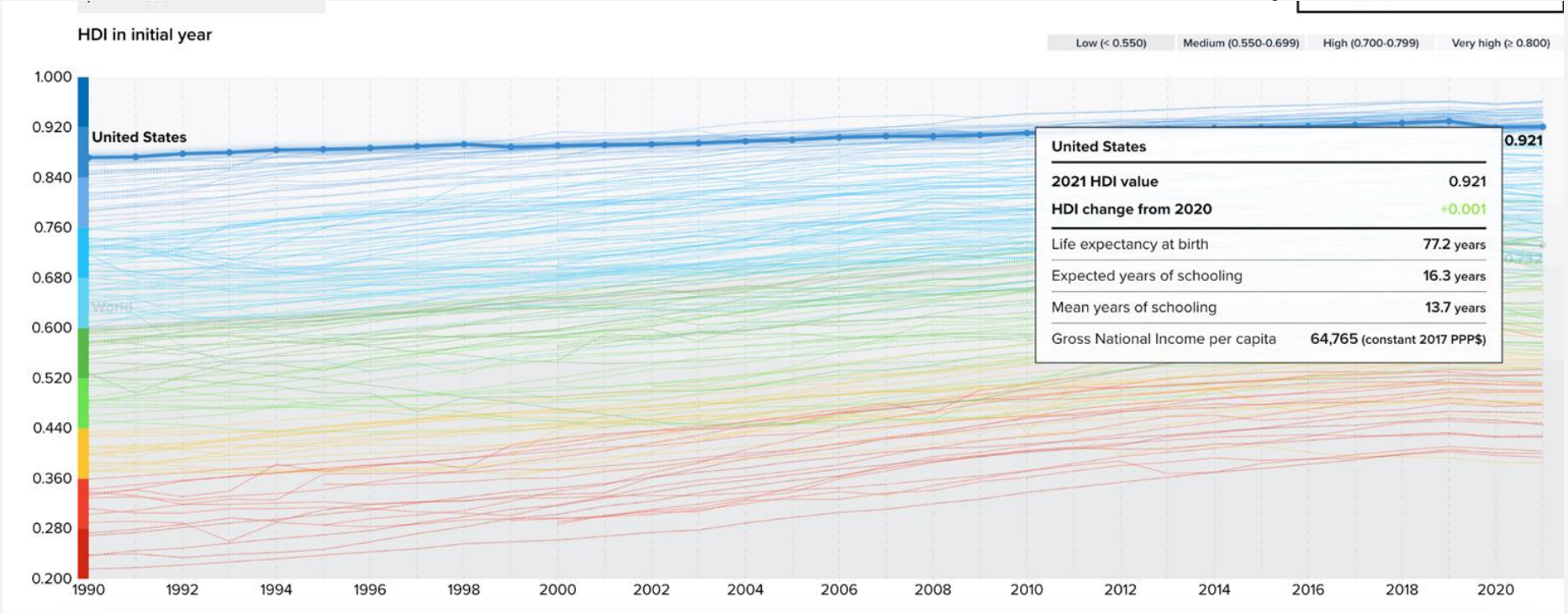

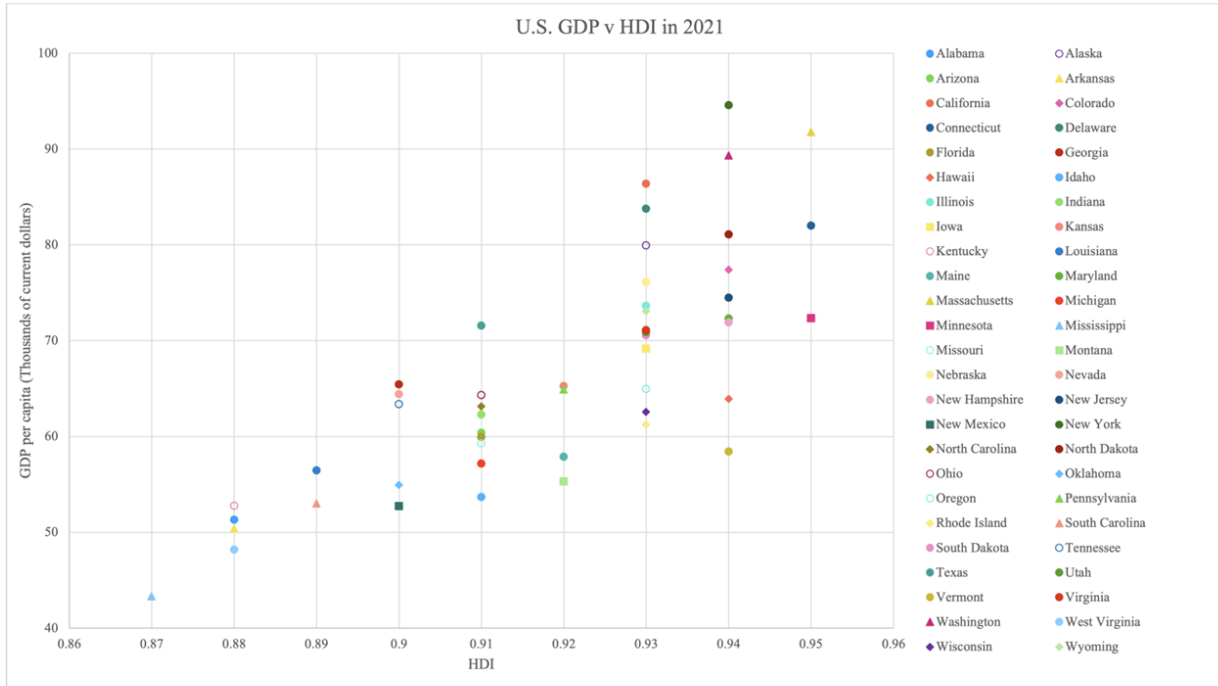


Figure 1: GDP Scatterplot Comparison to HDI for the United States in 2021

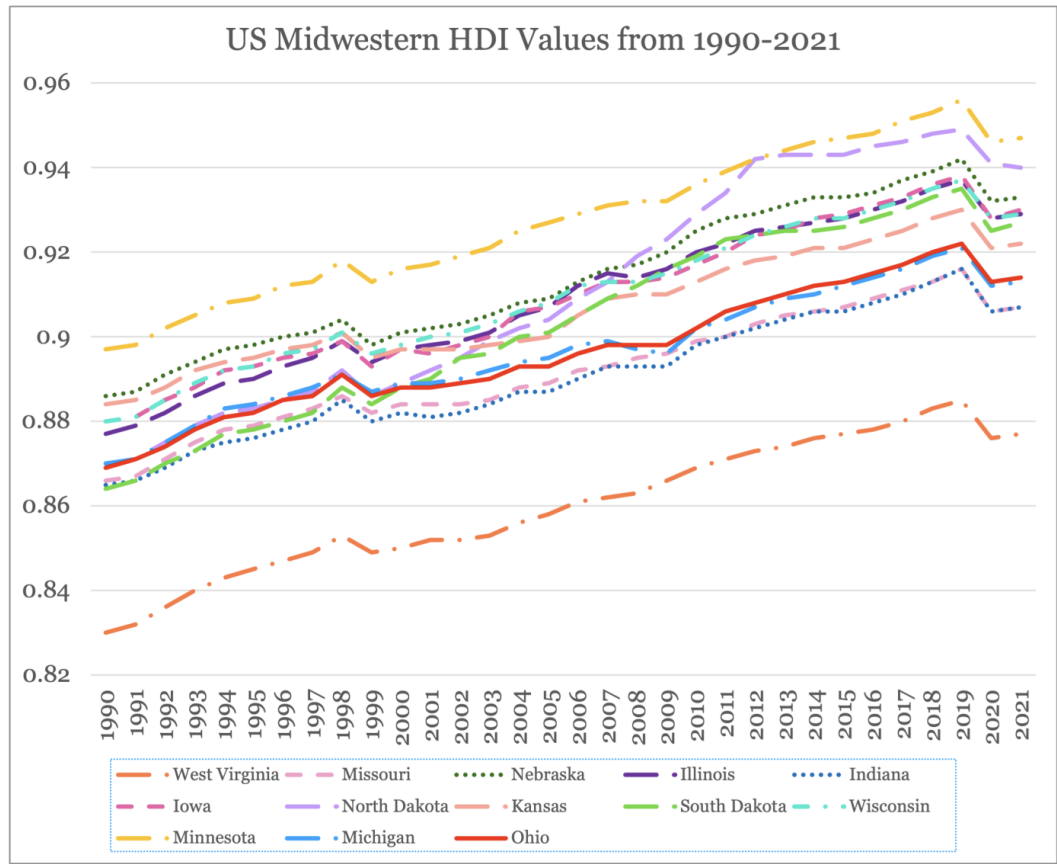


Figure 2: US Midwestern HDI Value From 1990-2021

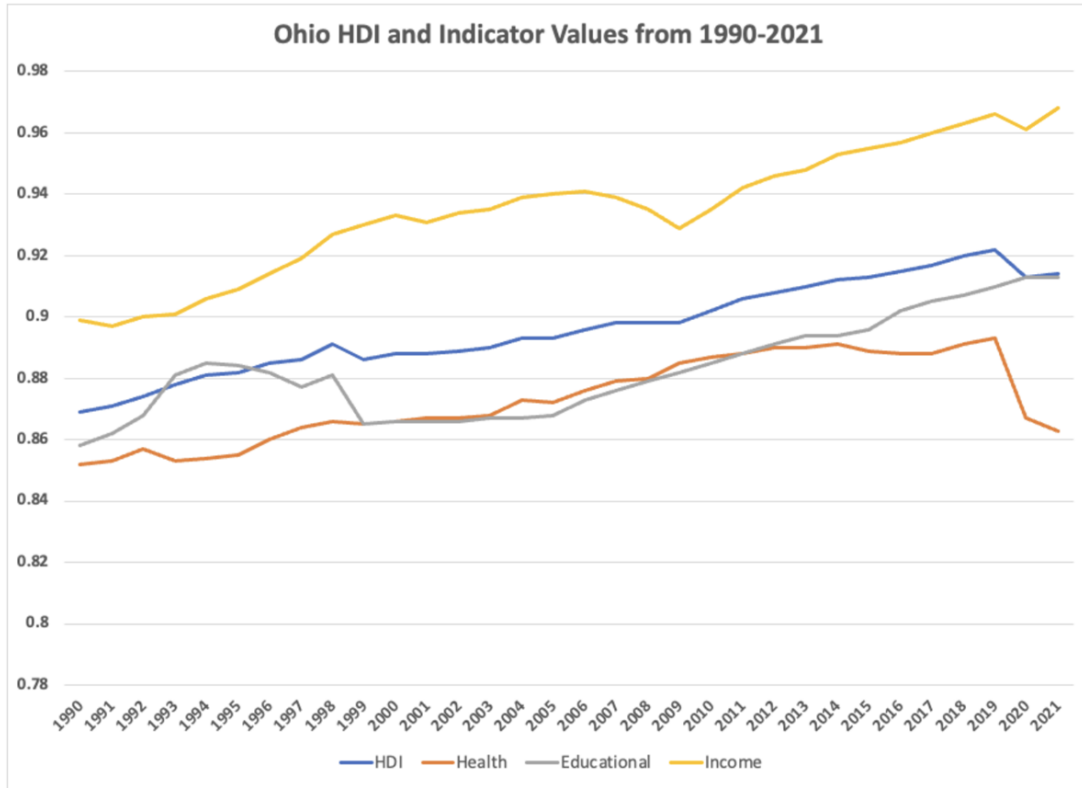
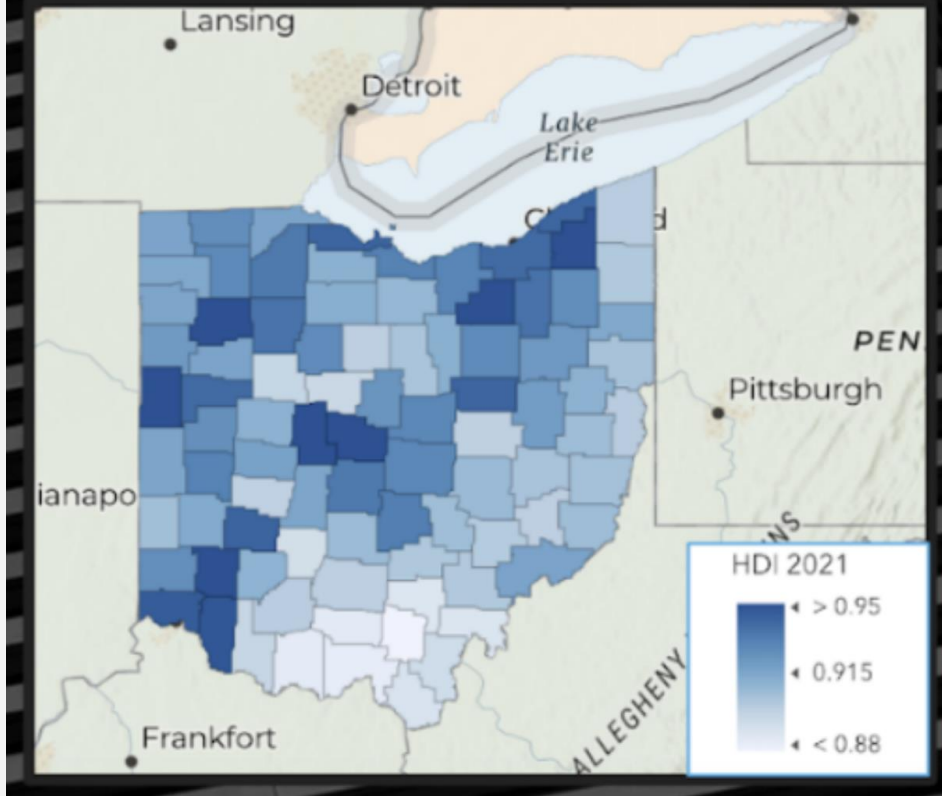


Figure 3: Comparing Ohio's HDI, Income, Education, and Health Index values from 1990-2021

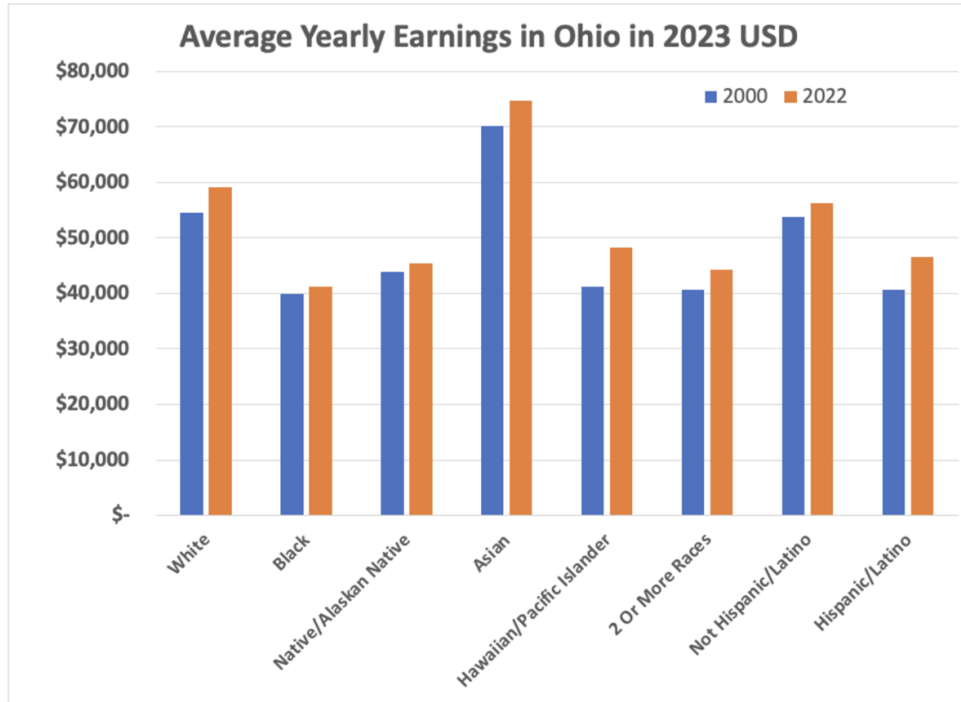


Figure 8: 2000 and 2022 Average Yearly Earnings per Employee in Ohio By Race in 2023 USD

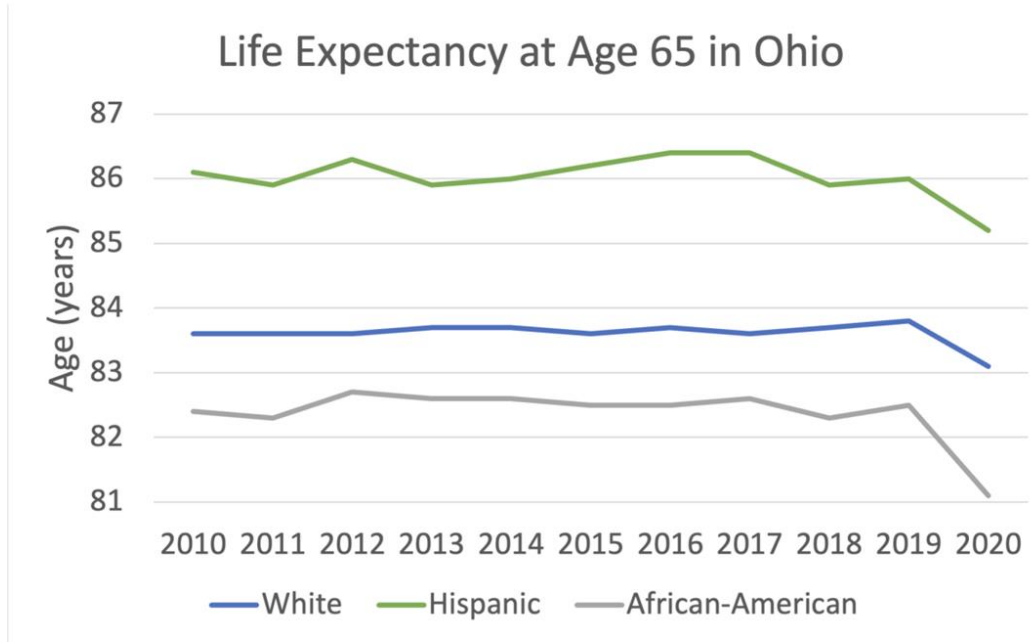


Figure 9: Life Expectancy for Different Races in Ohio Over 10 Years

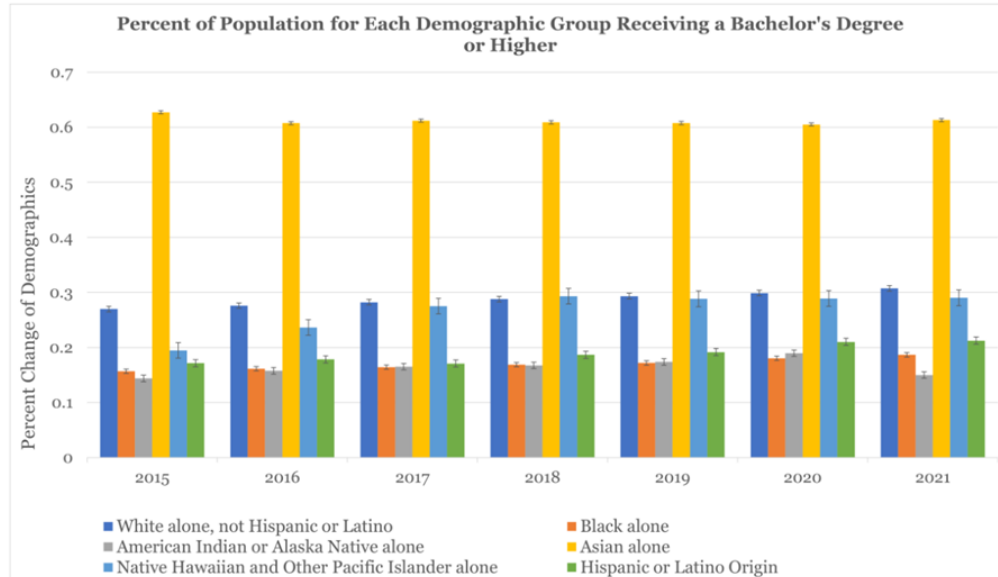
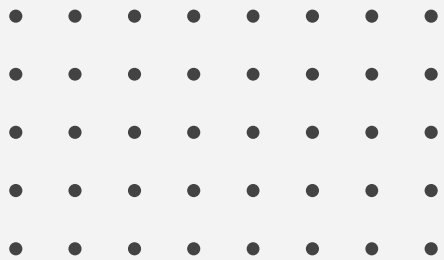


Figure 10: Demographic from 2015-2022 Based on Receiving a Bachelor's Degree or Higher
