

DEVELOPMENT STRATEGIES: FREEWAY PROJECTS

OBJECTIVES AND PERFORMANCE MEASURES

Minimize the amount of extra, or buffer, travel time necessary when planning expected trip travel time.

- 2024 Measure: Travel time reliability ration less than federal threshold: 94% interstates

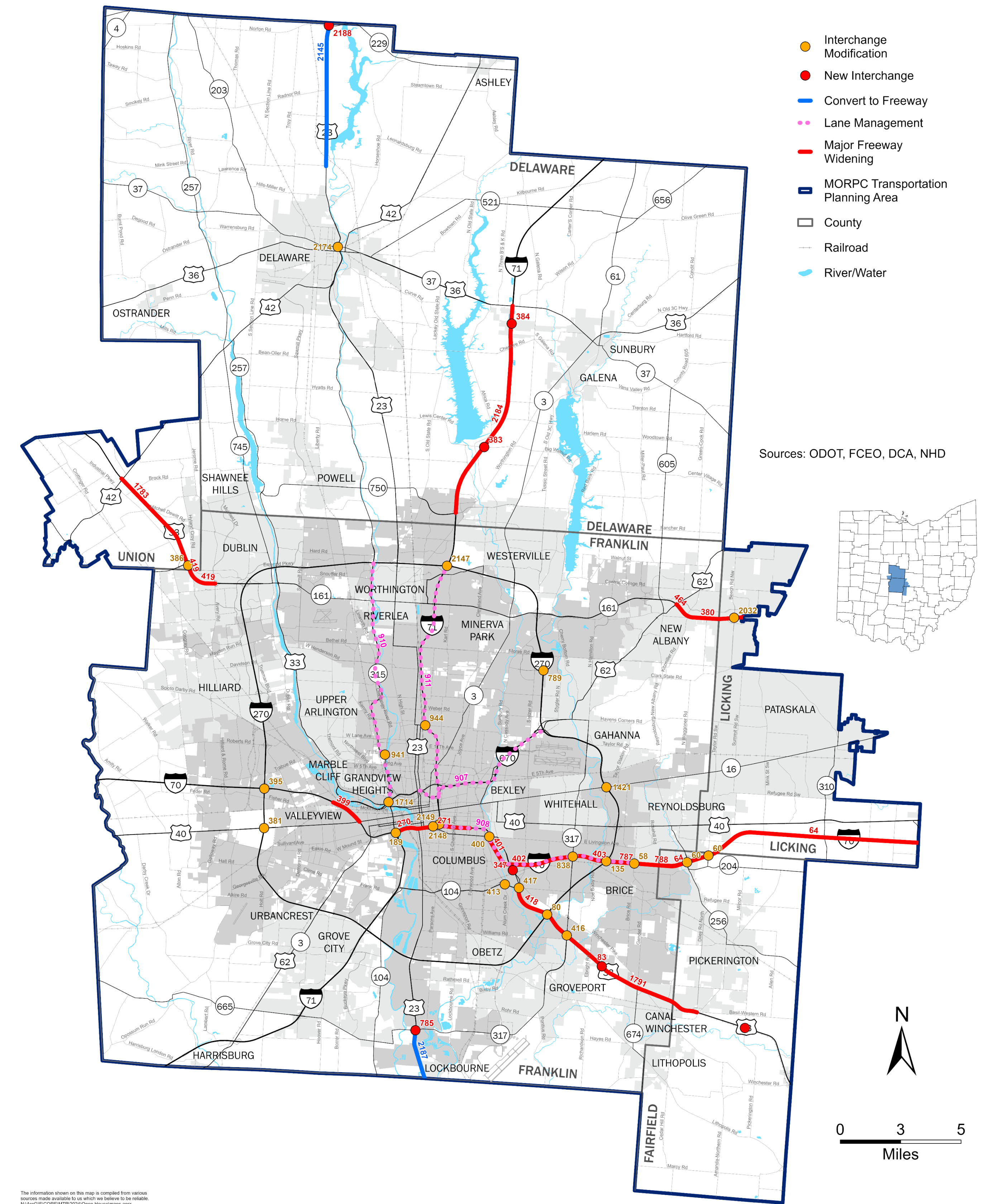
PRIMARY STRATEGIES

- Add capacity, where appropriate, to alleviate existing or anticipated congestion along existing freeways and at interchanges
- Continue conversion of key divided expressways into limited access freeways
- Construct new interchanges, where appropriate, to alleviate congestion or support regional development goals

INCLUDED IN THE DRAFT MTP:

- 20 miles of freeway conversions
- 48 miles of freeway widening
- 23 interchange modifications
- 8 new interchanges
- \$3.9 billion
