Draft Network Assessment

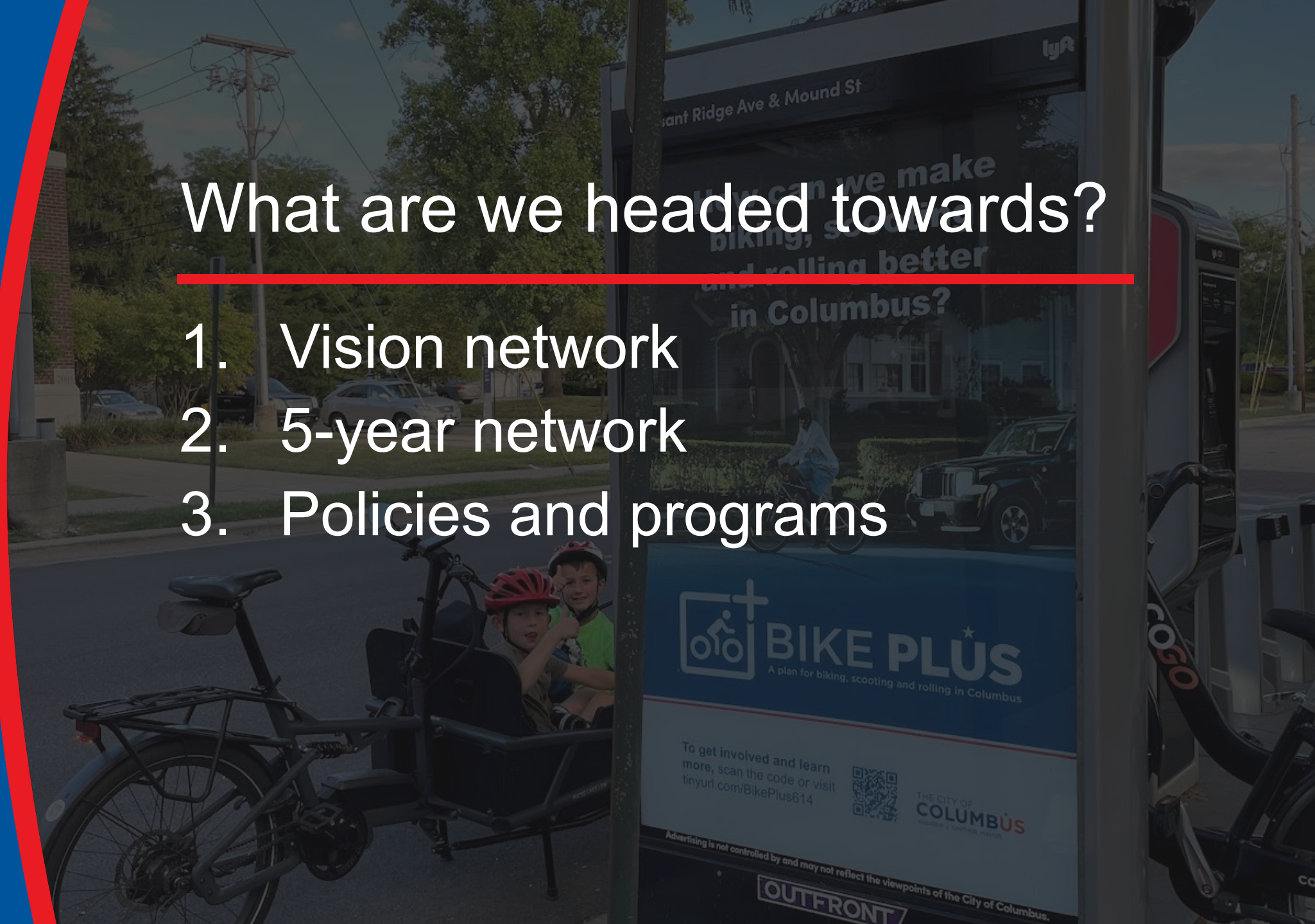
1. Six performance metrics
