### STATEWIDE SAFETY UPDATES

- Ohio Traffic Safety Council
  - Safety Belt Task Force
    - Final recommendations report
    - Primary seat belt law?
  - Ongoing Pedestrian Safety Working Group
  - Potential for an Impaired Driving Task Force
- SHSP Update to launch in September
  - Federal requirement to update every 5 years
  - Due in November 2025


- ODOT VRU Assessment Posted:
  - Vulnerable Road User Assessment

- Crash Data for 2023 is Final
  - Total crashes down, but multiple agencies have stopped reporting (PDO) crashes
  - Serious injuries down 1% compared to 2022, still around 2019 levels
  - Fatalities down 3% compared to 2022, still high (far above 2019 levels)


## FATALITIES AND FATALITY RATE

# SPEED LIMITS FOR LOCAL STREETS - SIMPLIFIED




### **Streets\*** within Municipalities

Speed Limit	Description	Code
15	Alleys	(B) 7
20	Active School Zone	(B) 1
25	Inside Business District, and all other routes not covered elsewhere	(B) 2
35	State Routes or Through Highways <i>outside</i> Business Districts	(B) 3
50	Controlled-Access Highways, Expressways, State Routes outside urban districts	(B) 4 (B) 6

### **Streets\* outside Municipalities**

Speed Limit	Description	Code
20	Active School Zone	(B) 1
35	Highways within an "island jurisdiction"	(B) 8 (B) 9
55	Highways	(B) 5


