*Provide transportation and mobility options to benefit the health, safety, and welfare of all people.*




*Protect natural resources and mitigate infrastructure vulnerabilities to maintain a healthy ecosystem and community.*




*Reduce per capita energy consumption and promote alternative fuel resources to increase affordability and resilience of regional energy supplies.*


## MORPC Safety Program






# GROWING OUR SAFETY PROGRAM

MORPC was awarded \$200,000 for the CORPO Planning Area!

- **Purpose:** Develop a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan for CORPO area
- **Timeline:** Fall 2023 through Spring 2024
- **Goal:** Coordinate with local agencies interested in applying for Implementation Grant in future years



#### Fatal and Serious Injuries Suspected Crash Percentages







(SS4A) FY24 Award (#3!) 


MORPC was awarded **\$2,120,000**


