

Stormwater Drainage Manual


The Stormwater Drainage Manual (SWDM) establishes stormwater control requirements for all new public and private development in Columbus.

First adopted in 2006, the Manual has only been updated 4 times (2012, 2021, 2022, and 2024).

Mural will educate about the importance of water, rivers, and watersheds in our daily lives.


Public vote and artist selected end of May/early June.







- Conserve environmentally sensitive areas


