Highlights of the SFY 26-29 TIP



- Includes nearly \$4.2 billion in funding for transportation improvements over the next four years
 - ~\$1.5 billion for roadway projects (including bike and pedestrian infrastructure)
 - ~\$2.7 billion for transit projects
- Includes over 360 projects in total, including:
 - Three LinkUS Bus Rapid Transit Corridors
 - 79 COTA (LinkUS) Transit Supportive Infrastructure projects
 - 45 projects receiving MORPC-Attributable Funding

Public Comments Received

- Public comment period closed on April 11th
 - 54 comments via interactive web map
 - 17 comments via email
 - 4 comments via April 2nd open house
- Comments did not necessitate any changes to the TIP
- Adjustments to project data were made to reflect the most up-to-date information
- No adjustments impacted the Air Quality Analysis or the Community Impacts Analysis
