## **Central Ohio Cycling Guide**

Will serve as an update to the Regional Bikeways
Plan – last updated in 2016. The Guide will reflect
updated cycling infrastructure and promote
MORPC's Trail Town efforts. The Guide is intended
to promote, encourage, market cycling in Central
Ohio for transportation. The guide will include:

- An update the Regional Bike Level of Stress Map.
- A 15-County Trail Map highlighting high comfort, engaging, and fun cycling routes.
- A safety assessment supported AI video imagery analysis.
- A Trail Town Story Map for 4 communities.

## **US-23 Active Transportation Study**

Develops an active transportation plan for the U.S. 23 corridor to complement the concepts identified in the Route 23 Connect Preliminary Feasibility Study and informs future evaluation of those concepts as implementation progresses. The plan will accomplish the following:

- Outline the regional vision, goals, and strategies needed to support safe, convenient, and accessible active transportation options.
- Document the current state of walking and biking within a 1.5-mile radius of the U.S. 23 corridor between I-270 and Waldo.
- Identify programs, policies, and infrastructure improvements to meet the needs of people walking and biking along and across the U.S. 23 corridor.
