Home Energy Efficiency Program (Weatherization)

Healthy Homes + Repair Program

Each program has different eligibility requirements. If applicants are ineligible for MORPC's programs, staff will redirect them to other resources in our region.

HOME WEATHERIZATION



Home energy efficiency (weatherization) - helps keep homes warmer in the winter and cooler in the summer, all while lowering energy bills and available to Franklin County residents.

Based on eligibility, customers may receive the following services at no cost:



Repair/replacement of furnaces and water heaters



Attic and sidewall insulation



Air sealing



A full home energy inspection



Safety checks on appliances



HEALTHY HOMES

- ▲ Healthy Homes & Repair Programs Improves health and safety so eligible homeowners can live safely and comfortably.
- ✓ Service Area Services homeowners in not only Franklin County, but outside the city limits of Columbus
- ▲ Approval Process Once approved, homeowners will receive a general home repair inspection and a healthy homes assessment.
- ▲ Healthy Homes Assessment Reviews eight areas of concern to keep homes:





Franklin County To See Significant Population Growth: 1.75 Million Residents by 2050

Recent data forecasts a significant population increase in Franklin County, with projections indicating growth to nearly 1.75 million residents by 2050. The historical estimates reveal steady growth over the past two decades, the forecast shows an acceleration in trends suggesting a robust future for the region.

The Cost of Home: Franklin County Home Prices Increase Compared to Incomes; Now Unaffordable for Many

Franklin County's median home sale price compared to the Columbus MSA's median household income has been increasing steadily. The ratio is in the moderately unaffordable range, and is nearing the seriously unaffordable range as home prices increase while incomes don't at the same rate. This means that intra-regional moves into Franklin County is becoming less attainable for home buyers.
