Good Morning All,

First, apologies for the delay in getting this out, and also, thank you all for your participation and contributions. Your assistance is invaluable in helping ensure that we can continue to move forward with some tangible degree of progress.

For those who weren't able to attend or want a brief recap, we spent most of the steering committee meetings discussing the roles and expectations for the working groups. We had initially identified four working groups, but the marketing & tourism group was slightly undersubscribed, so we did away with that one for now. The three remaining groups met ahead of the steering committee meeting to discuss all potential options for projects and priorities, and the steering committee discussed as a whole which of those ideas would make the most sense to move forward in the face of potential overlap.
