- ▲ Capital and operating grants for public transportation services to meet the mobility needs of seniors and individuals with disabilities
- ▲ Example Projects:
 - Purchase of replacement vehicles
 - Contracted transportation
 - Preventive maintenance
- \$8.5 million in Section 5310 funding has been competitively awarded by MORPC since 2019



PROGRAM MANAGEMENT PLAN (PMP) INFORMATION



What the PMP is - MORPC's goals, procedures, policies, and requirements for administering Section 5310 program. Intended to facilitate recipient management and FTA oversight.

PMP Purpose - Used as basis for FTA management reviews, to provide public information on recipient administration of program, and internal guide for program recipients.

PMP Update - Formally updated in 2015, informally updated in 2022 without FTA adoption. Seeking to formally update PMP with FTA approval in 2025.

PMP UPDATE SUMMARY



5310 Advisory Committee - Created in 2022 cycle for 5310. Oversees review of project scoring by MORPC staff and recommends program of projects (POP). Members serve two-year terms. Committee consists of:

- ▲ Franklin County 2 members appointed
- Delaware County 2 members appointed
- ▲ Community Advisory Committee (CAC) 1 member appointed
- ▲ Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) 1 member appointed
- ▲ Private Sector 1 member appointed from healthcare industry
 - ▲ Preferably with focus on seniors or individuals with disabilities

Committee Representatives - MORPC will soon be asking for 5310 Advisory Committee representatives from CAC and TAC

SEMIANNUAL REPORTING



Finances and Operations - All sub-recipients receiving operating assistance will be required to report financial and operating data on a semiannual basis.

Rider Demographics - To comply with Section 504 and ADA reporting requirements, MORPC requires subrecipients to include demographic info of riders in semiannual project reports, including both a disability and ethnic breakdown of the population served.

Formstack Application - MORPC utilizes Formstack software for better record keeping and oversight of applications. Applicants should ensure that applications are being submitted to MORPC's Formstack portal, not ODOT's portal.

TRANSIT ASSET MANAGEMENT (TAM) PLAN INFORMATION



What the TAM is - MORPC's inventory of vehicles funded by Section 5310 across all subrecipients, updated annually for adding new vehicles and removing properly disposed vehicles. Separate document from PMP.

TAM Purpose - In addition to the count of 5310 funded vehicles, the TAM plan assesses the condition of all vehicles in 5310 fleet, methodology used to estimate capital investment needs over time, and a project-based prioritization of investments.

FTA Transit Award Management System (TrAMS) - MORPC staff will have oversight in the federal TrAMs system to execute and close grants for Section 5310 projects.



UPDATE TIMELINE

June - Notify CAC and TAC of 2025 PMP update

August - Present draft to CAC and TAC for review and comment. Nominate representative for 5310 Advisory Committee

September - Submit final draft to FTA for formal approval



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
