## Goals

- To assess current and future water resource availability and demands across the 15-county region.
- Identify areas with water-related gaps and surpluses
- Help community leaders make informed decisions about water infrastructure and community investment in a way that protects natural resources and supports economic growth.

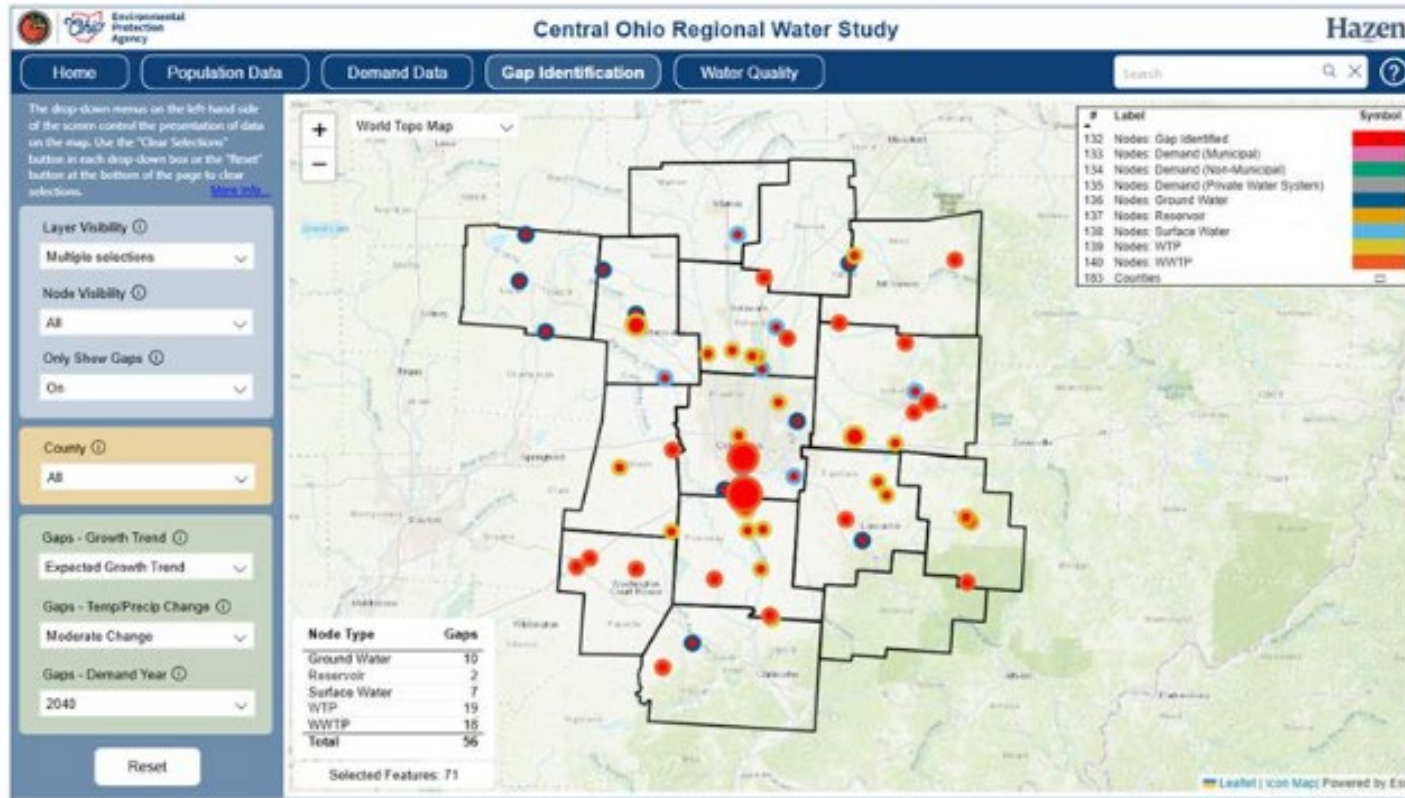


# KEY FINDINGS

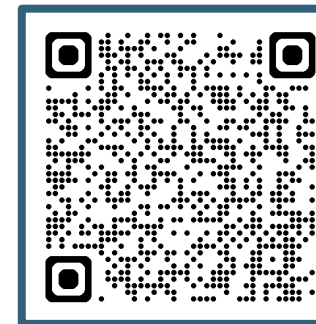
- Current water volumes in the 15-county region are generally sufficient to meet current and anticipated drinking water demands.
- Projected residential and economic growth may require additional infrastructure investments in water and wastewater facilities and/or the advancement of water recycling strategies.
- Raccoon Creek, South Fork Licking River, Deer Creek, Big Darby Creek, and Lower Scioto River (Pickaway County) watersheds are the most vulnerable to impacts from development

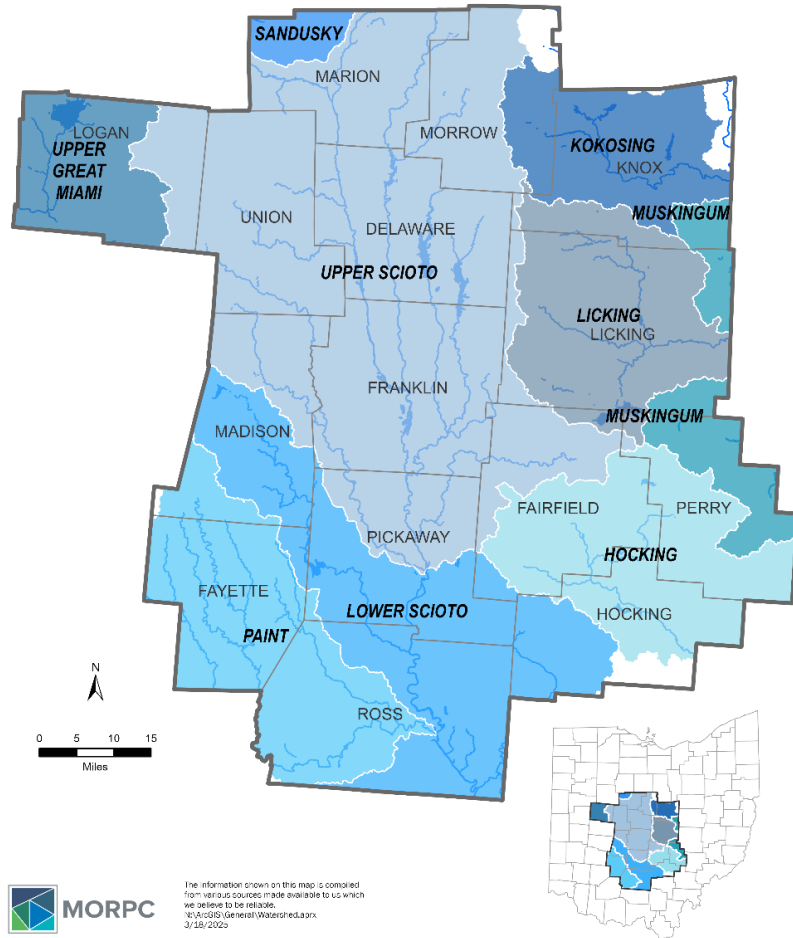
