- Trails

PARKING LOTS


- Design to AVERAGE Demand
- 50-foot setback minimum
- Mark parking spaces



- Vegetated Filter Strips
- Grassy Swales
- Infiltration Trenches
- Sand Filters









TRAILS

- Clearly signed and defined
- Avoid removing vegetation
- No chemically-treated wood

MATERIALS

- Permeable pavement (high-use)
 - Prone to root damage
- Crushed stone (low-use)
 - Prone to erosion

Access Point Typology	Recommended Material	Material Cost (Per ft ²)
High Use- Urban	Permeable Pavement such as Porous Asphalt	\$7-\$13
High Use- Rural	Permeable Pavement such as Porous Asphalt	\$7-\$13
Low Use- Urban	Permeable Pavement such as Porous Asphalt	\$7-\$13
Low Use- Rural	Crushed stone	\$6-\$10




LAUNCH POINTS

- Use gradual slopes (8%)
- Avoid alterations
- No obstructions in flood zones

MATERIALS

- Natural Materials
- Concrete
- Stair Step





SITING CONSIDERATIONS

- Stream routing
- Shape of the banks
- Accessibility for use and maintenance

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Low exposure to wind and currents
- No physical barriers
- Ideal water quality and levels
- Low lateral movement
- Clear visibility from the water
- No sensitive areas




CENTRAL OHIO BLUEWAYS ORG. STRUCTURE


