


CORPO Dedicated Funds Program

- Part of the biennial transportation budget (SFY 2026 2027)
- Suballocation of Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG)
- Funds can be used for BOTH capital and planning projects

CORPO Dedicated Funds Program

- CORPO is seeking funding applications
- Around \$2.4 million available in 2-year cycle
 - Suballocated amount and carry-over from SFY 24-25 funding around
- Application due on August 8, 2025, at 5 PM
- Online application form is available on the CORPO webpage

Eligibility

CORPO will open an application round for the State Fiscal Year 2026 – 2027 CORPO Dedicated Funds program. Starting on **July 7, 2025** CORPO will seek funding applications for the two-year funding cycle for transportation projects and programs from eligible local public agencies located within CORPO's member counties.

These funds may be used for construction, expansion, reconstruction, preliminary engineering, right of way or preservation of roads and bridges on any public road; capital costs for public transit and bus terminals; bicycle and pedestrian facilities; and other transportation-related activities. Open-Ended Questions

If you feel you must submit additional information, please do so as an attachment. An attachment upload option is provided as the last step of the application and should only be done once you are sure you are ready to submit the application.

Save and Resume

You will be able to save a partially completed application by capturing and saving a unique link or you may also choose to have this link emailed. When you are ready to revisit the application, you will simply click or paste the unique application link into a browser, and the application will reload with any fields that had already been filled in. If you make any changes to the application, <u>make sure you re-save and resend or capture the application link</u>.

File Attachments

On the final page of the application, you are provided with sections to upload an attachment with any additional information and the application signature page. This is the final step of the application process.

It is important to understand that you should not attach any files until you are ready to submit your application. The Save and Resume Later option does not support file attachments.





- 2. If requesting a certain dollar amount, choose the *Dollar Amount* method, enter the dollar amounts for each funding source. The form will calculate the percentages and total sub-phase cost.
- 3. If cost estimate types below do not apply to the project please select "Not Applicable" and proceed to the next question.

Preliminary Engineering

CORPO expects project sponsors to undertake preliminary engineering (PE) on construction projects without the use of CORPO-dedicated funds.

<u>PE – Environmental/Preliminary Development</u>: Enter costs to prepare the environmental document and develop the project through Stage 1 design plans.

<u>PE – Detailed Design</u>: Enter costs to develop the project to right-of-way authorization or Stage 2 design plans.


- a) Staff shall apply the scoring criteria to applications for new funding commitments.
