The average car uses about 0.15 gallons of fuel per hour of idling. That's about 45 cents' worth of gas. If you do that at least once a day for 250 days, that's \$112.50 a year at \$3 a gallon. Not only does that cost a lot it is also horrible for the environment! Did you know that every 10 minutes your engine is off, you'll prevent one pound of carbon dioxide from being released (carbon dioxide is a major contributor to global warming)? Idling increase the amount of vehicle exhaust in the air. Exhaust contains many pollutants that can cause asthma and other lung diseases, allergies, heart disease, greater risk of infections and cancer and other health problems.
