



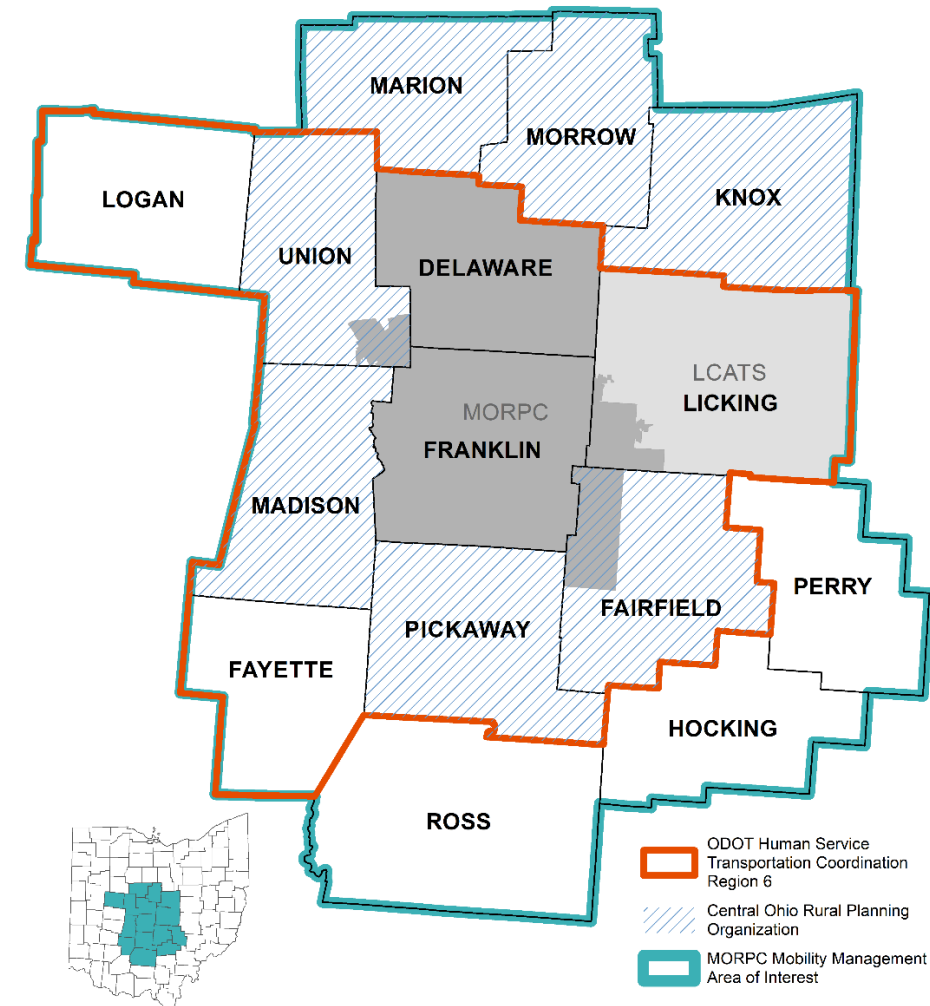

# ODOT HSTC Regions

- ODOT established ten Human Services Transportation Coordination (HSTC) regions in Ohio.
  - The Regional Mobility Plan serves as the Transit Coordinated Plan for ODOT HSTC Region 6
- Regionalism goals:
  - improve service delivery
  - increase regional coordination
  - reduce duplication
  - fill gaps in service



# REGIONAL MOBILITY PLAN

- Purpose:
  - Required by the Federal Transit Administration for funding
  - Priorities for future federal, state or local funding
  - Plan for each county and an over all regional nine county plan
- Goals:
  - *Identify* community resources
  - *Understand* mobility gaps and unmet needs
  - *Determine* education and awareness strategies
  - *Prioritize* local and regional

# PROJECT TIMELINE

## January - March

- Public announcements and meetings
- Kick off continuous local-level meetings and regional steering committee

## April - June

- Survey outreach
- Data and map review
- Review best practices
- Workflow trip maps in and out of each county
- Prioritize goals and strategies
- County commissioner engagement

## July - September

- Draft and finalize county sections
- Draft regional intentions and action steps
- Review survey results
- Stakeholder engagement

## October - December

- Open plan for public comment with public meetings
- Obtain and act on feedback
- Finalize plan
- Approval from seven county commissions, and MORPC
- Submit final to ODOT
