PROJECT OVERVIEW

This project will improve the safety, capacity, and operation of the US-23 and I-270 interchange by removing two cloverleaf ramps, constructing two new signalized ramps, rehabilitating two structures, and resurfacing portions of I-270 and US-23.

The scope of work is based on the recommendations from the South Outerbelt Study (PID 25733 - TRAC funded).
