The project includes 2 inches of new asphalt, compact aggregate shoulder, thermoplastic pavement markings, and roadway signage. Safety improvements will be incorporated into the project.

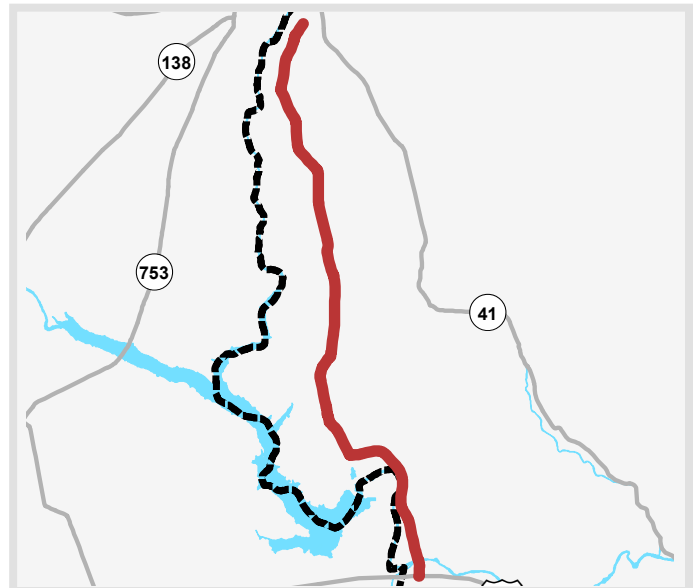
