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REGIONAL DATA USER GROUP WORKING GROUP
Action Plan

This working group is established in support of the Regional Data Advisory Committee's goal that MORPC foster collaboration among local governments, partners, and stakeholders to enhance the use of data in Central Ohio. Under that goal, the RDAC identified an objective to convene meetings of local government staff responsible for creating and maintaining the region's data resources.

One action item in support of that objective, and identified as a priority by the RDAC, is to support the creation of a new Central Ohio data user group. Completing that action will be the purpose of this group.

SCOPE & TIMELINE:

The Regional Data User Group Working Group will complete the following tasks in order to inform the implementation of a new Central Ohio data user group:

1. Define the purpose and value of the user group to various stakeholders in the region.
2. Determine the hosting structure of the user group.
3. Compile a list of organizations and specific organizational roles or individuals to invite to the user groups.
4. Identify an initial meeting format and schedule that best-enhances the user group's regional value.
5. Create and implement a communication plan to ensure a successful launch of the user group.

The Working Group will meet monthly with the goal of establishing the User Group by the first quarter of 2020.

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
