- Other demographic and livability factors













Highlights Include:

- Decreased number of high ozone days over time, mostly due to emission reductions.
- "Good" air pollution levels increased.
- High ozone days 2 days in July were unhealthy for sensitive groups.
- No unhealthy for sensitive groups days for particle pollution.
