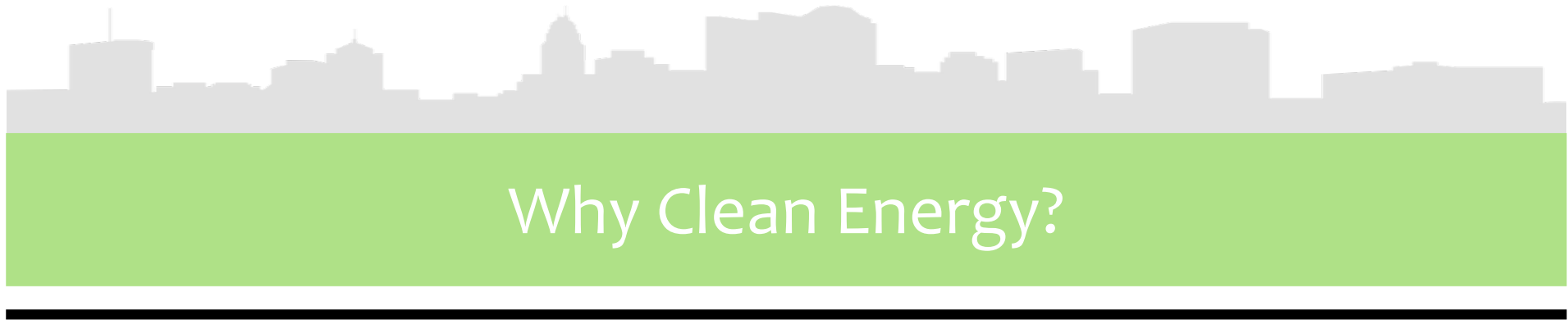

Clean Energy Supports Public Health

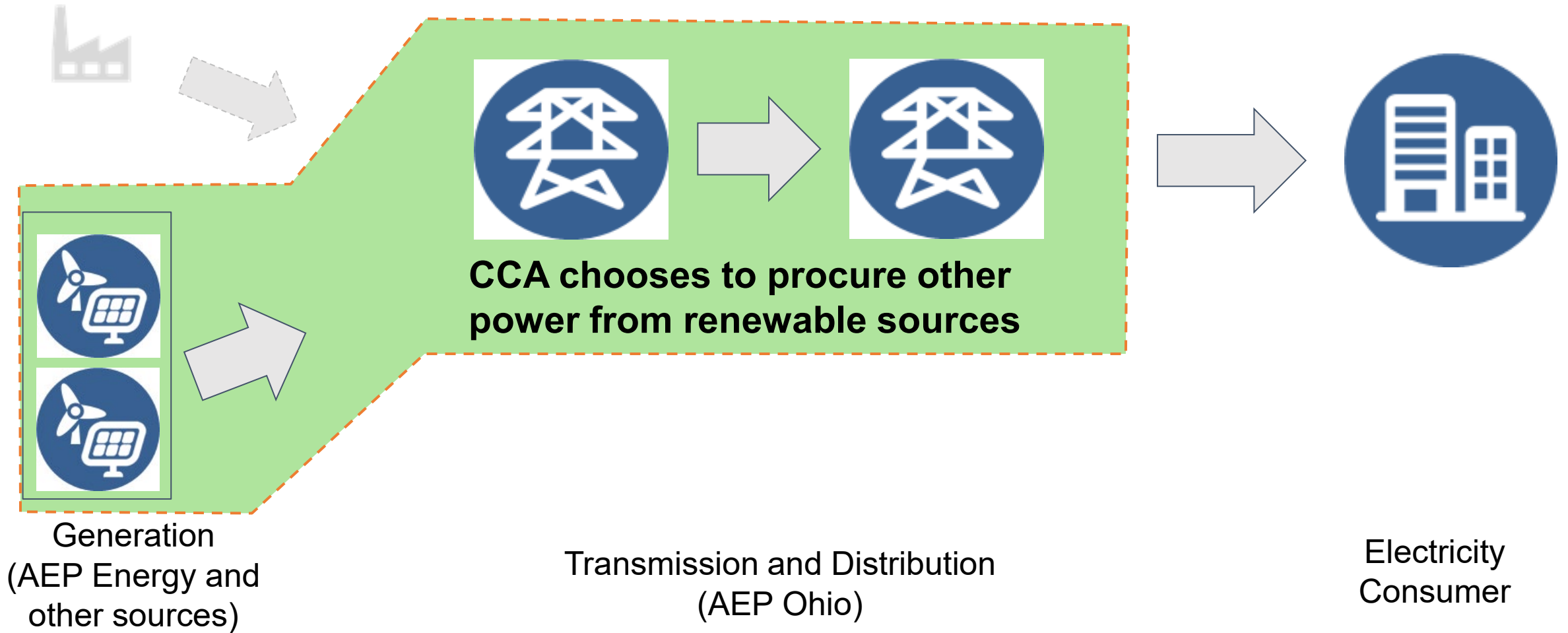
- 700MW of renewable energy displacing fossil fuel generation could result in **\$210 million** of avoided healthcare costs in Ohio over 20 years.
- Specifically, this means:
 - **22** fewer premature deaths,
 - **654** fewer cases of breathing illnesses,
 - **6,480** fewer school days missed, and
 - **1,080** fewer work days missed.

These benefits are for EVERYONE, whether or not you participate in the aggregation program

Give consumers competitive electricity prices

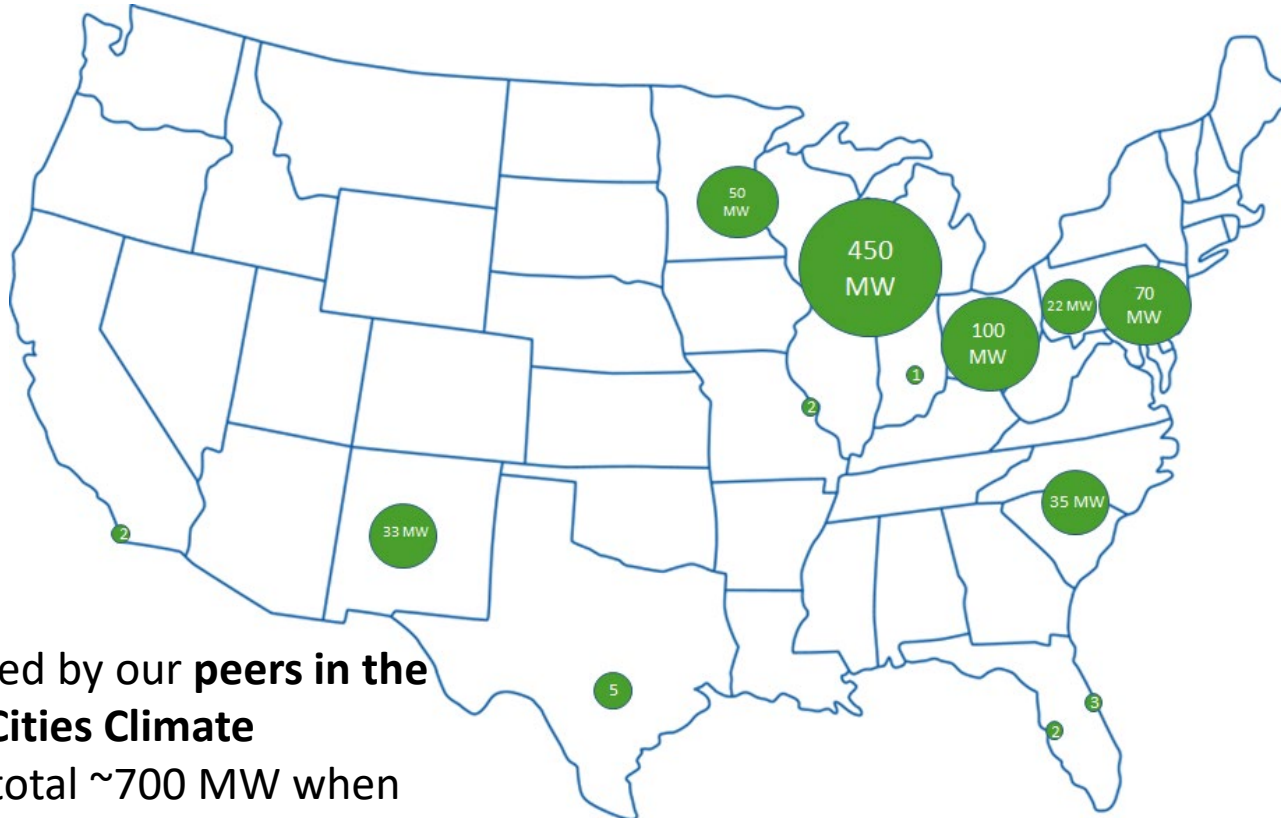


Expand and leverage consumer choice



Columbus' aggregation program will be one of the largest CCAs in the country

Columbus residents will see **700 MW** of Solar and Wind installed in Ohio



To put this in perspective, looking across the other American Cities Climate Challenge cities pursuing PPAs, it is roughly **equivalent to all other cities combined**

PPAs pursued by our **peers in the American Cities Climate Challenge** total ~700 MW when combined

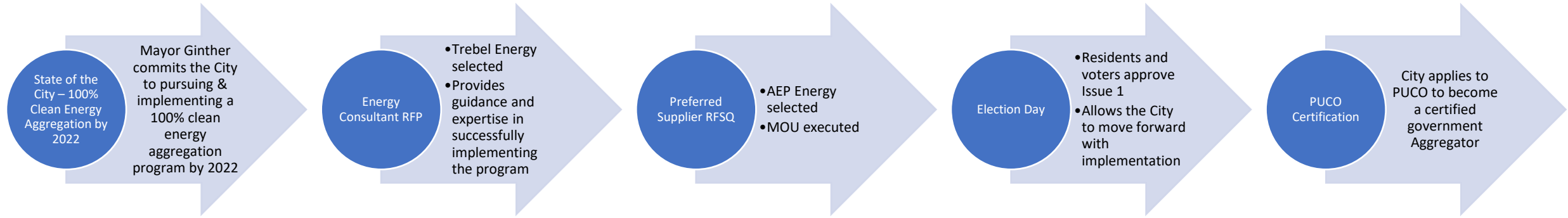
