MORPC

- Commits ODOT funding for Major New Capacity Program projects
- Criteria for project eligibility:
 - Overall cost over \$12 million
 - Increase capacity and/or reduce congestion
 - Proves to support jobs and/or job creation
- MPOs provide ODOT a local project prioritization recommendation

2020 Cycle suspended

Accelerated 2021 Cycle

- Option for 2020 TRAC applicants to leave applications as submitted
- 2020 application revisions need to let Jim Gates (TRAC Manager) know by March 1
- New Applications to be accepted within application period
