- Advance projects through advocacy and technical assistance






PROCESS

- County working groups determine top 3-5 local priority projects, with 6 "regionally significant" projects






Round 3 Results

- 47 projects
- 12 counties identified projects
- Pickaway and Morrow counties participating for the first time
- Projects total over \$5 billion
- Range from \$800,000 to over \$2 billion
