- Advance projects through advocacy and technical assistance



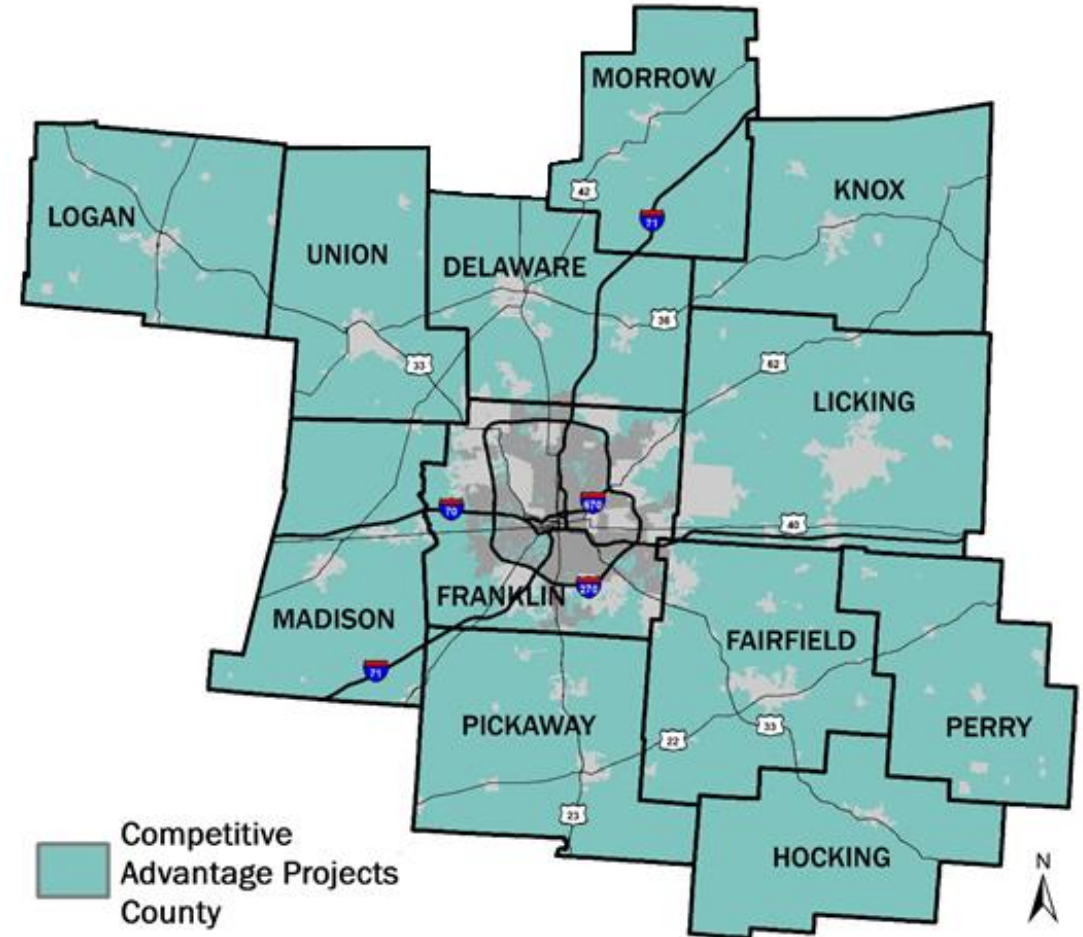

Driven at the County Level

- Organization of county-based working groups
- MORPC provides data and support to facilitate prioritization
- County working groups determine top 3-5 local priority projects, with 6 “regionally significant” projects

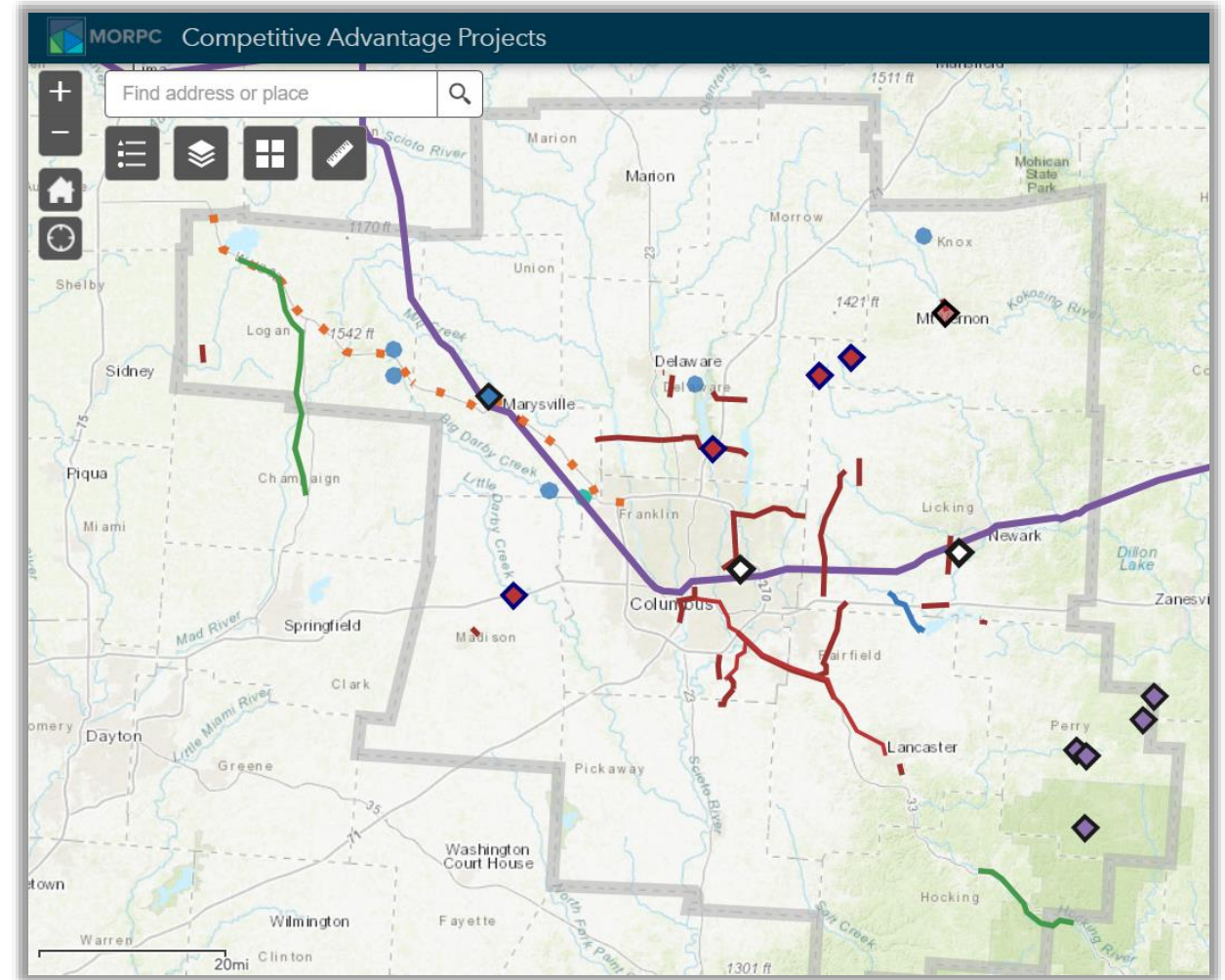
MORPC staff tracks funding opportunities and assists with funding strategies

- 12 counties identified projects
- Pickaway and Morrow counties participating for the first time
- Projects total over \$5 billion
- Range from \$800,000 to over \$2 billion

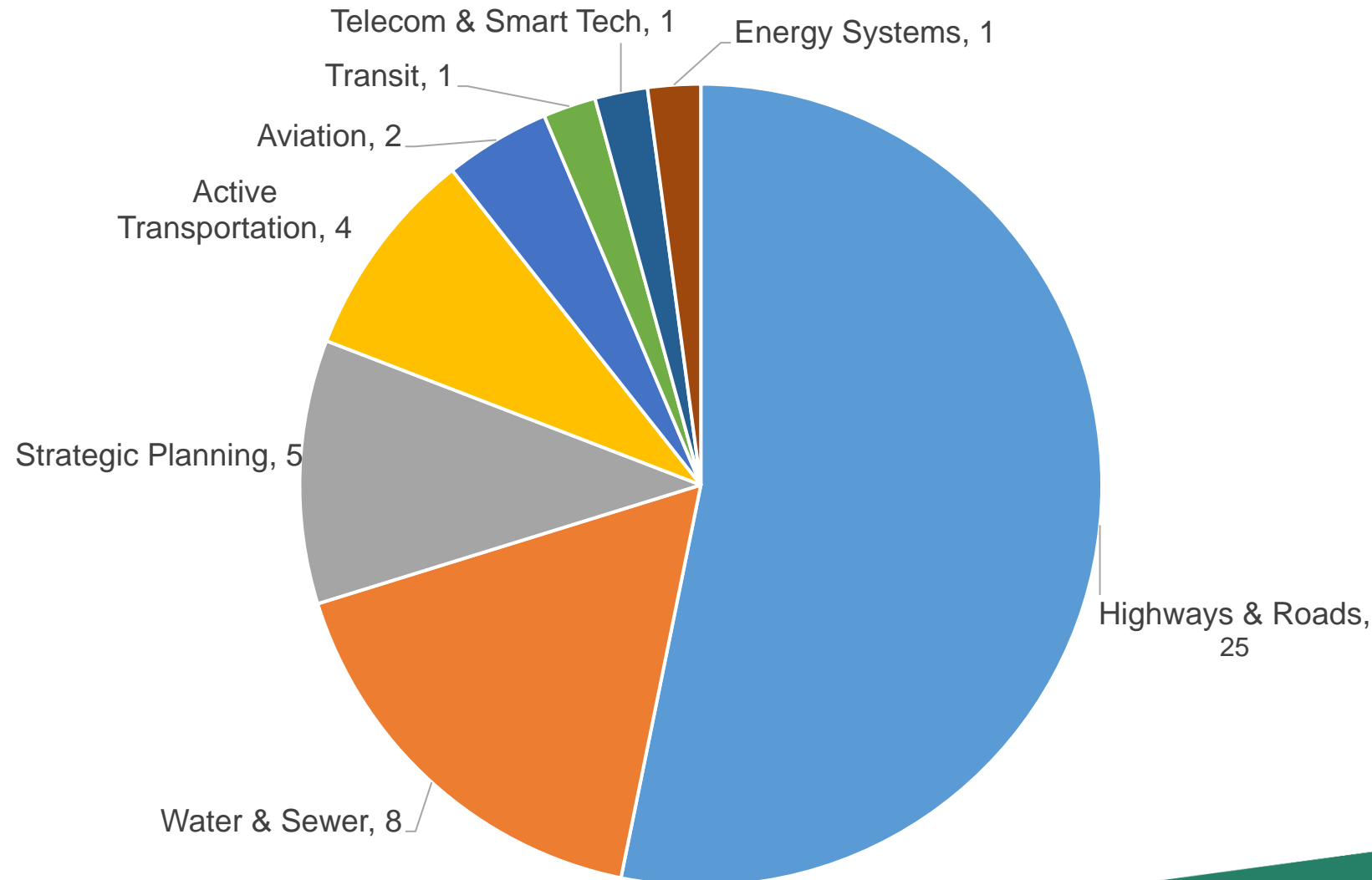
