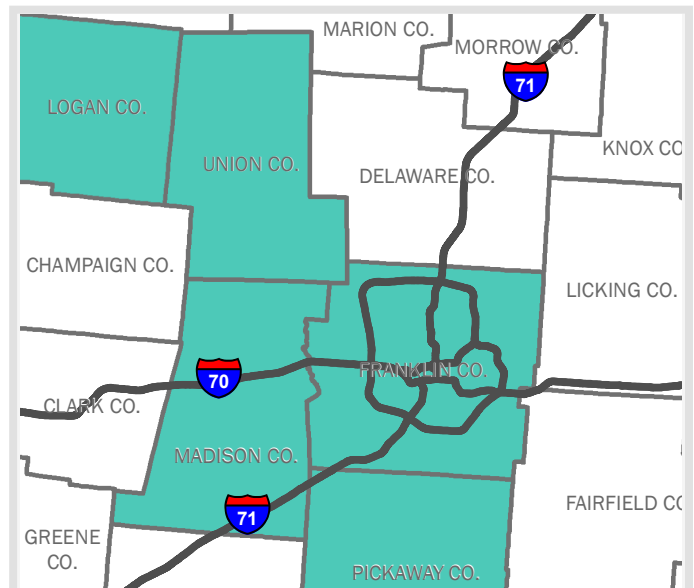

Project Benefits

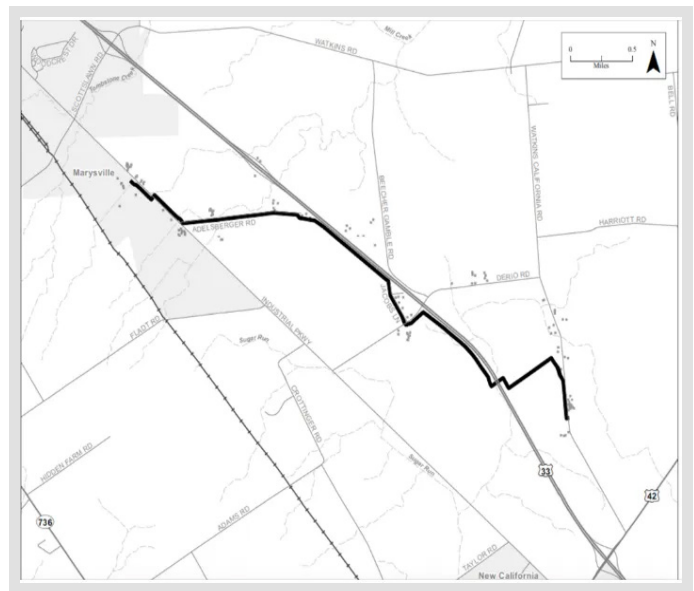
- Maintains competitive infrastructure by extending natural gas lines into underserved areas
