### Downstream Woodlands

Georgesville, Darbydale and Harrisburg represent three existing villages that have premier access to the most wildlife habitat in the region. A light touch and addition of local eatables, irris and destinations will allow for exploration of the region while preserving existing natural character and respecting endangered mussel habitat.

- Enhanced Camp Chase Trail connects parklands to the Village Neighborhood
- Canals, inlets over the river corridor
- Yards along creek edge for overnight stays
- Endangered mussel habitat
- Georgesville, Pleasant Township
