

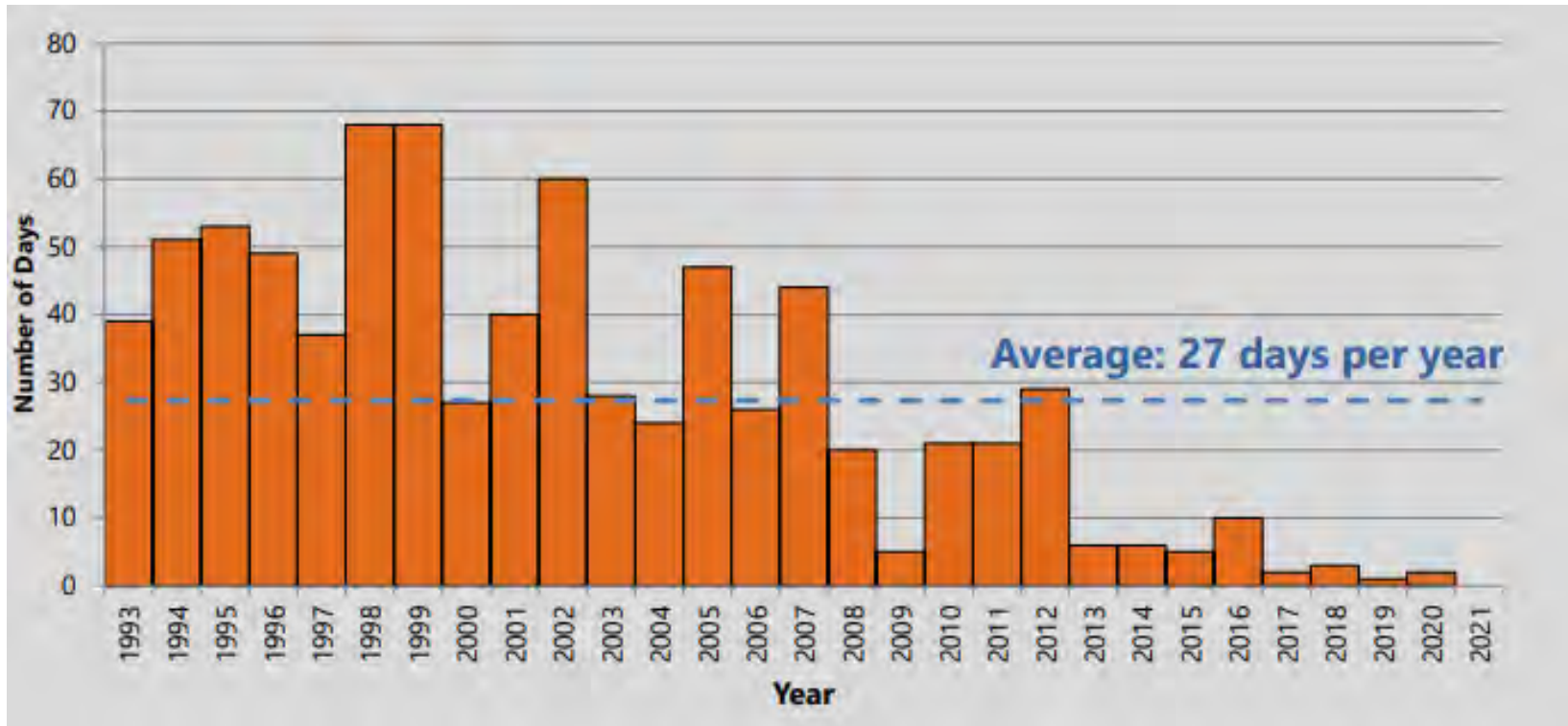

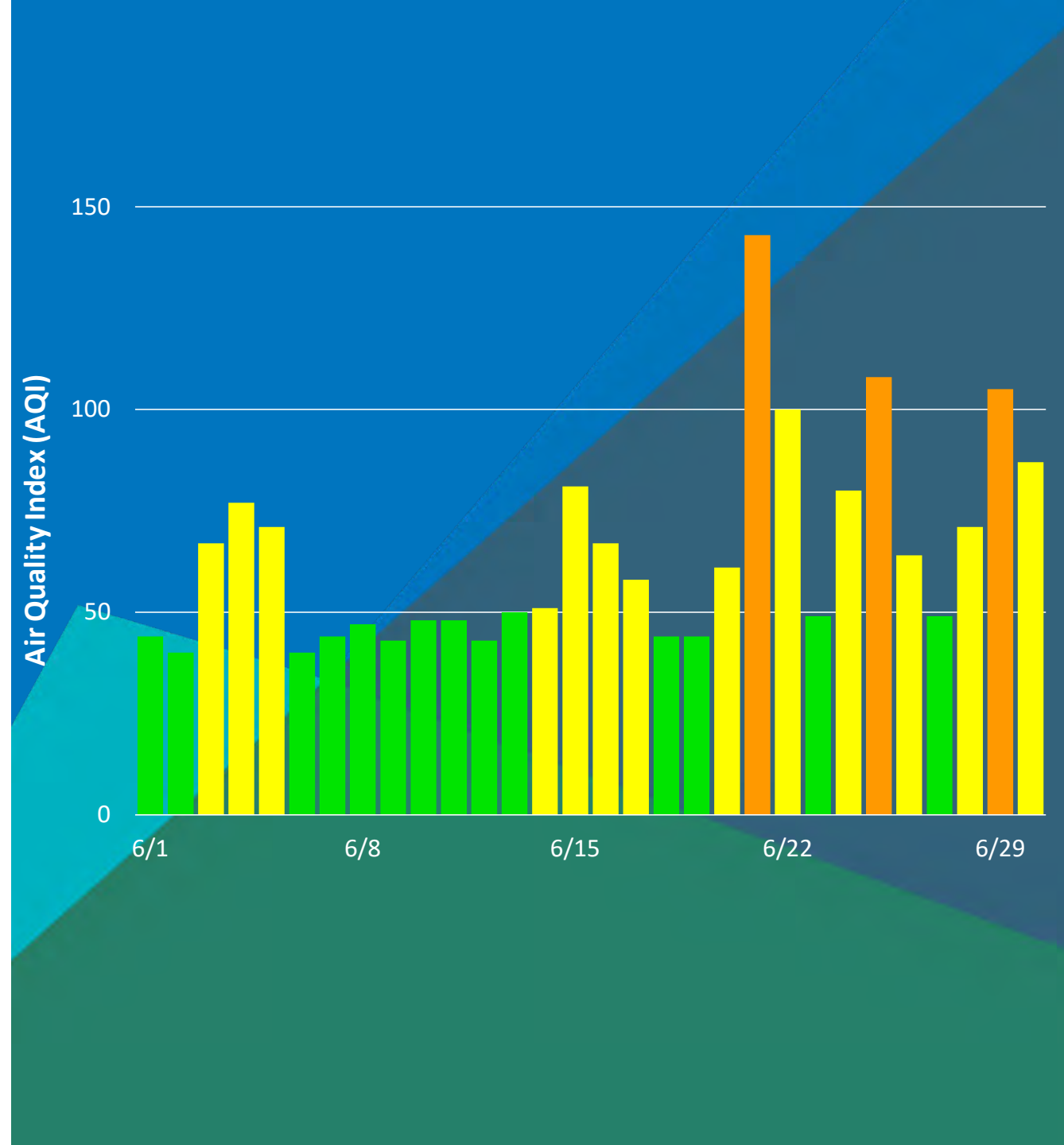
GOOD NEWS FOR AIR QUALITY



Continuous trend of improvement over last 29 years

JUNE 2022 RE-CAP

- AQI levels observed in June 2022
- First month MORPC issued an Air Quality Alert in nearly 2 years.
- Ozone precursors – high temps in mid-90's, wildfire smoke, and light winds


